

Beginning with the 2nd payment, 1/10 of the principal or \$20.00 paid on each installment bears interest from September 1, 1937, to the time the installment is paid.

### TAX\*ASSESSOR\*COLLECTOR

In order that a uniform system of collecting delinquent taxes on the installment plan as authorized by House Bill 456 may be used, we shall suggest that you follow on of the examples shown on the attached exhibit in arriving at the amount of taxes, penalty and interest that should be paid by a delinquent tax payer who pays his taxes on the installment plan.

If you desire to divide the taxes into ten (10) equal installments, the second example of computing the samount of the taxes, ~~penalty~~ penalty and interest to bepaid should be followed.

Immediately after September 1, kindly advise this department the number of tax payers in your county who have taken advantage of the partial payment plan of paying their delinquent taxes.

On receipt of the information we will immediately prescribe the forms and etc., as required by Section 12 of the Bill, to be used by you in collecting the taxes.

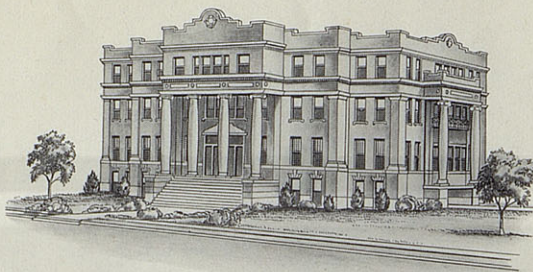
