Major Robert M. White Camp 1250

Texas Senate Resolution No. 526, dated March 30, 1999, resolved that April be celebrated as Confederate History Month in Texas "to honor those men and women who died for Texas, and also all the Texans who came afterward and benefited from their legacy of honor and devotion to our state."

The Major Robert M. White Camp 1250 will hold a Grave Rededication Ceremony today at 1 p.m. at South Belton Cemetery. There are at least 32 Confederate Veterans buried in that cemetery, and this ceremony is intended to honor them by rededicating their final resting places. After the pledges to the flags, there will be a keynote speaker, followed by the reading of the veterans' names. A wreath laying will be done while the poem, *Ode to Confederate Dead*, is being read.

The ceremony will be followed by refreshments and social time. There will be a firing squad, many men dressed in Confederate uniforms and some of the ladies will be in period dress.

Please come out and help us honor those brave men who joined the Confederate armed forces to defend their homes, their families, and their proud heritage as Texans.

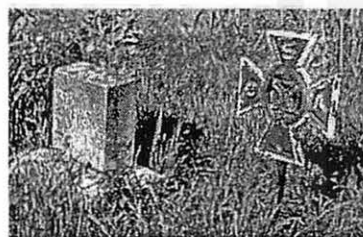

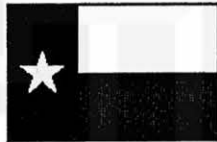

Having spoken with you on April 30 concerning the matter of publishing the Roster of Ex-Confederate Veterans, now on display in the Bell County Museum, and upon further consultation with Stephanie Turham, director Bell Co. Museum, Vida Sutton, Bell Co. Clerk and the executive committee of the Sons of Confederate Veterans, Maj. Rebet M. White Camp, I have taken the liberty to draw together a proposal for cooperation between the Lena Armstrong Library and the Sons of Confederate Veterans for the purpose of producing and marketing.

a CD Rom of the Roster of Ex-Confederate Veterans.

1. In accordance with accepted conservation practice and under the supervision and by the assistance of the staff of the Bell Co. Museum the Roster will be photographed by a representative of the S.C.V. who will retain the copyright of the photos.
2. The S.C.V. will submit the photos to Heritage Press who will develop a CD Rom product for sale to the public with the royalties paid to the Lena Armstrong Library and the Maj. Robert M. White Camp S.C.V. No. 1250 on a 50/50 basis.
3. Heritage Press will furthermore make copies of the CD Rom available to both the S.C.V. and

the Lena Armstrong Library at
1/2 retail.

4. The copyright to the photos and the CD Rom will transfer to Heritage Press during production but will revert to the SCV representative at a stipulated time. This temporary transfer of copyright is understood to be standard and acceptable practice.
5. It is understood that this proposed production and sale of the CD Rom and the copyright mentioned above in no way inhibits or precludes the photographing or republication or transcription of the Router by anyone at any time and the sale of such reproductions as may be subsequently granted by the director of the Lena Armstrong

Library.

6. It is also understood that the City of Belton, the Lena Armstrong Library and the Bell Co. Museum will be free from obligation for any and all cost incurred in the photographing, publishing and marketing of the CD Rom.
7. It is understood that the format for the CD Rom of the Roster would present each photographed page with a transcription beside it.
8. The work of photographing will be done in June of 2003 or as soon as appropriate arrangements for the work can be made.

The above preparations are offered
in the spirit of deep appreciation
for the faithful preservation of
this Roster of Ex-Confederate Veterans
by the Lena Armstrong Library
and the efforts of the present
director, Kim Kroll, to properly
conserve and promote a knowledge

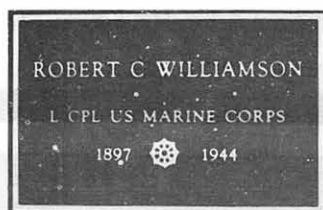
ILLUSTRATIONS OF STANDARD GOVERNMENT HEADSTONES AND MARKERS

UPRIGHT HEADSTONE WHITE MARBLE OR LIGHT GRAY GRANITE



This headstone is 42 inches long, 13 inches wide, and 4 inches thick. Weight is approximately 230 pounds. Variations may occur in stone color, and the marble may contain light to moderate veining.

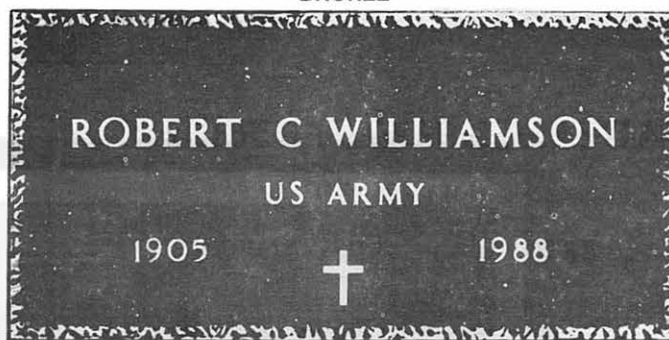
BRONZE NICHE



This niche marker is 8-1/2 inches long, 5-1/2 inches wide, with 7/16 inches rise. Weight is approximately 3 pounds; mounting bolts and washers are furnished with the marker. For use if entombment is in a columbarium or mausoleum, but not to supplement a private monument.

FLAT MARKERS

BRONZE



This grave marker is 24 inches long, 12 inches wide, with 3/4 inch rise. Weight is approximately 18 pounds. Anchor bolts, nuts and washers for fastening to a base are furnished with the marker. The base is not furnished by the Government.

LIGHT GRAY GRANITE OR WHITE MARBLE



This grave marker is 24 inches long, 12 inches wide, and 4 inches thick. Weight is approximately 130 pounds. Variations may occur in stone color; the marble may contain light to moderate veining.

NOTE: In addition to the headstone and markers illustrated, two special styles of upright marble headstones and flat markers are available to mark the graves of - those who served with the Union Forces, Civil War, or during the Spanish-American War; and those who served with the Confederate Forces, Civil War. Request should be made in block 27 of the application. It is necessary to submit detailed documentation which supports eligibility.

INSCRIPTION INFORMATION

MANDATORY ITEMS of inscription at Government expense are: Name, Branch of Service, Year of Birth, and Year of Death. Branches of Service are: U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Coast Guard, and by exception, U.S. Army Air Corps, and other parent organizations authorized for certain periods of time. Different examples of inscription formats are illustrated above; **deviations in data sequence are not permitted.** More than one branch of service is permitted, subject to space availability.

OPTIONAL ITEMS which may be inscribed at Government expense, indicated by shaded title blocks are: military grade, rate or rank, war service, month and day of the dates of birth and death, an authorized emblem reflective of one's belief, and the valor awards and the Purple Heart listed in block 8. If any of these items are desired the information must be shown clearly in the shaded title blocks; documentation of the awards must accompany the application.

RESERVED SPACE for future inscription at private expense, such as spousal or dependent data may be authorized below the standard inscription if requested in block 27. Only two lines of space may be reserved on flat markers due to space limitations. Reserved space is unnecessary on upright marble or granite headstones as the reverse side is available for future inscriptions.

MEMORIAL HEADSTONES AND MARKERS (remains are not buried). The words "In Memory of" are mandatory and precede the authorized inscription data. The words "In Memory of" are not inscribed when remains are buried.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS may be inscribed at applicant's expense, **subject to VA approval**, below the standard inscription and subject to space limitations. Some additional inscription items may, of necessity, be placed on the rear of the headstone. Such items may be terms of endearment, nicknames (not unseemly in nature) in expressions such as OUR BELOVED POPPY, LOVINGLY CALLED DUTCH, representations of military and civilian participation or accomplishment, and titles such as DOCTOR, REVEREND, etc. These requests should be made in block 27. The manufacturer will bill the applicant for the cost of the additional inscription. Such requests delay the processing of the application and marking the veteran's grave.

INCOMPLETE OR INACCURATE INFORMATION ON THE APPLICATION MAY RESULT IN ITS RETURN TO THE APPLICANT, A DELAY IN RECEIPT OF THE HEADSTONE OR MARKER, OR AN INCORRECT INSCRIPTION.

MEMORIAL HEADSTONE OR MARKER - Furnished upon application by a relative recognized as the next of kin for installation only in a cemetery to commemorate any veteran whose remains have not been recovered or identified, were buried at sea, donated to science, or cremated and the remains scattered; may not be used as a memento. Check box in block 2 and explain in block 27.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE - Any deceased veteran discharged under conditions other than dishonorable. To expedite processing, attach a copy of the deceased veteran's discharge certificate or a copy of other official document(s) pertaining to military service, if available. **Do not send original documents;** they will not be returned. Service after September 7, 1980, must be for a minimum of 24 months or be completed under special circumstances, e.g., death on active duty. Persons who have only limited active duty service for training while in the National Guard or Reserves are not eligible unless there are special circumstances, e.g., death while on, or as a result of training. Persons with extended Reserve or National Guard service which entitled them to retirement pay subsequent to October 27, 1992, are eligible; a copy of the Reserve Retirement Eligibility Benefits Letter must accompany the application. Active duty service during the Persian Gulf War for all referenced above also establishes eligibility. SIGNATURES REQUIRED - The applicant, next of kin or other responsible person, signs in block 15, obtains the signature of consignee in block 22 and cemetery official in block 24. If there is no official on duty at the cemetery write "NONE" in block 24. State Veterans' Cemeteries are not required to complete blocks: 15, 16, 22 and 23.

ASSISTANCE NEEDED - If assistance is needed to complete this application, contact the nearest VA Regional Office, national cemetery, or a local veterans' organization. No fee should be paid in connection with the preparation of this application. Use block 27 for any clarification or information you wish to provide. Should you have special questions when filling out this form, please telephone our Applicant Assistance Division toll free at: 1-800-697-6947.

INSTALLATION - All costs to install the headstone or marker must be paid from private funds.
