

DISTINCTIVE ITEMS OF UNIFORM

1. a. In accordance with provisions of Par 57e and Par 62, Section VI, SR 600-60-1, Distinctive Items of Uniform, the scarf, in appropriate color for each branch, as authorized in Par 52 SR 600-60-1, is prescribed as an item of uniform for all personnel for off-duty wear. Scarf may be worn in lieu of tie in the manner illustrated in cited regulation.

b. Insignia, Collar, disc, Infantry, Blue, EM, is prescribed as an item of uniform for all enlisted personnel in the following units:

Hq & Hq Co, 36th Infantry Division
Each Unit: 141st, 142nd, 143rd Inf Regt

2. In accordance with provisions of Section V, Logistical Matters, Adjutant General's Department, State of Texas, Bulletin Vol 4, No 6, dated 20 May 53, following units are authorized initial issue of one each per individual (Officer & EM actual Strength) Scarf, and 2 ea per EM (Actual Strength) Insignia, Collar:

Hq & Hq Co, 36th Infantry Division
Each Unit: 141st, 142nd, 143rd Inf Regt

3. The scarf, for branches other than Infantry, will not be made available through supply channels; however it may be procured locally from unit funds.

4. Officers assigned to General Staff sections will wear Infantry Blue; those assigned to Special Staff sections will wear the color prescribed for their branches. Infantry Blue will be worn for branches not listed in Par 52 SR 600-60-1.





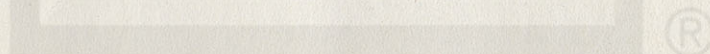
