1779, April 2, Fragmentary letter

Dear Sir

April 2nd 1879

Your complacence in your letter to my Mother, of my not writing to you since you left Virginia; I think nothing great reason; but be assured it has not been for want of regard, or inclination, you know. Brown-Meck is an out of the way place for travelers; it's by accident of I ever hear of any person going to Philadelphia. I have written you of C. A. Mead had he not set off a week sooner than I expected. — We have been tantalized with Congress having been very important New from Europe, Peace upon Noble Terms which was to have been ~~commenced~~ proclaimed last Saturday the 27th March in every State. In consequence of which, the Merchants shut up their stores, & took all from 12.10 to 1 P.M. indeed they

would not buy it at any price. Inform you
 I do not think the fact necessary from the South
 forwade. Peace if far from it the enemy -
 have not men to over one. I do all most nothing
 ahead, I am afraid they are in hope of them of
 Charles Town; tho' the Marquis is going to them
 assistance every day. The French Army is not
 more than 600 good men, and with 1000
 they will give a good account of them. -
 I have given Robert 1000 Dollars to bear
 his expenses, I should have inclosed you
 some, to buy a few things for selling. Very
 well, but have not any more except 200. At
 May, ~~but~~ all events must get the favour
 of you, ^{the King} mentioned the men. I'd you can
 advance the money. 12000 Dollars for salary, £30 of
 the 1000 Dollars is to pay for salary & 1000
 My wife has sent you a present of two
