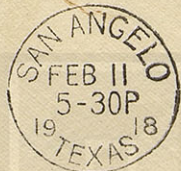

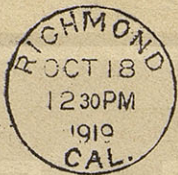

Sacred to the Memory of Our Mother.

When, on the 16th day of May, 1902, in the old home town of Seguin, the soul of Mrs. Elizabeth Duggan drifted away from the frail, worn body into the great beyond, it was not the closing of an ordinary life. for our mother was gone to meet her reward in heaven. May God magnify her name and character in our lives.

Mother's maiden name was Elizabeth Berry. She was born in Claiborn County, Mississippi, on the 8th day of May, 1816. She was married to our sainted and departed father, Thomas H. Duggan, of the same State, in 1835. She was 18 years of age, and within two years of their marriage they, with their baby girl, came to Texas and adopted the (then) Republic as their home. At first they settled near Austin, and we, their children, have heard both of them tell over and over of the strange, hard, pioneer life they lived in this then wild country. But mother proved equal to all the emergencies laid upon her, and we, her sons and daughters, can bear cheerful testimony to her wonderful endurance and energy and capabilities.

Being driven back by the Indians, our parents again settled near Columbus, on the Colorado River, and from there they moved to Port Lavaca, the head of navigation—then a very small place. In 1845 they moved to Guadalupe County and settled near the town of Seguin, on the San Geronimo, and spent the balance of their lives in this (Guadalupe) County.

Our father was the first County Clerk of Guadalupe County.

Father and mother were members of the first Methodist Church organized in Texas, Rev. Homer S. Thrall being pastor. While we were children our father served many terms in the State Legislature, both in the House of Representatives and in the Senate, and we well remember the most excellent management of dear mother during father's stay in Austin. We then lived on the farm, six miles east of Seguin, and the care of children, negroes, crops and stock was all on mother, and how well do we remember the delight of father upon his return home at the splendid judgment and management of mother over the home affairs.

Dear mother's hands were never idle, and though, as in all lives, many sorrows and disappointments came, she never failed, but continued to trust in God till the very last.

Twelve children were born to our parents. Only five are now living. One son, just 18 years of age, died at the beginning of the Civil War, and at its close our father, after years of true devotion and service to his country in so many ways, left us for his home in heaven.

It was then that our dear mother, in her deep grief and amid the dense gloom that overshadowed our entire country, did her best, battling as she did with poverty, sorrows and gloomy feelings. She met all as bravely as she could, and now she, too, has left us, and we do miss her so much and our hearts are so sad, for we fear we never appreciated her as we should.

The home of our parents was always the home of the ministers of the gospel, and at any hour of the day or night they found a hearty welcome.

We are too sad to write more. We are too poor to erect costly monuments to the memory of dear father and mother. But we can and do pray God in his mercy to qualify us to lead lives that may serve as monuments to them, for the Christian training that they gave us and the lives they lived was all that any earthly parents could bestow.

The next in our series of Travis County will extracts is indexed for you immediately following the will data. We hope to be able to repay the two ladies who gave us their work by* extending it to 1900 for them. Volunteers should see Mrs. Claude B. Tate for this job.

We hope you look over the different methods of making indexes; we like that used for the Brides of St. David's Church--the numbers are closer to the names.

Thomas H. Duggan and Elizabeth daughter of Thomas and Mary Berry were married in the County of Claiborne State of Mississippi on the 20th day of May A. D. 1834.

Births

Thomas H. son of Edmund and Elizabeth E. Duggan was born in the County of Jefferson State of Mississippi on 20th day April A. D. 1815.

Elizabeth wife of Thomas H. Duggan was born in the County of Jefferson State of Mississippi on 8th day May A. D. 1816.

Mary Elizabeth daughter of Thomas H. and Elizabeth Duggan was born in the County of Jefferson State of Mississippi on the 30th day September A. D. 1835.

These St. David's Episcopal Church records are printed in our quarterly as a unit so that they may (if desired) be removed without disturbing other data published here. The early records of this church are of importance to Austin genealogists and historians--as well as to the large number of present residents who are descendants of these early settlers and citizens in the Austin area--because they are among the earliest records in this section. Many of the men & women concerned were active in the early history of Travis & neighboring counties and in our government and military.

It is the intention of AGS to publish other early records from this church as the difficult and time-consuming work of abstracting, organizing and indexing them progresses. As the records before 1900 become available for publication, we hope to place them in future quarterlies as units which may also be removed and collected into one volume of records concerned only with St. David's. It is believed that these records will include births, christenings, baptisms and communicants, burials, and other church activities. One unit might possibly be completed by our Sept. or Nov, 1961, publication dates; but it cannot be certain.

We appreciate being allowed to publish and preserve these records in this way. Available copies protect the originals & are valuable to students & congregation.

MEMORANDUM

Washington County, Ga. Novr. the 26th, 1837.

Dear Nephew

Yours of the 23rd of Septr. was gladly recd. in due time in which we are informed of the afflicted situation of your family prior to your writing but at that time all was giting well again which we are truly glad to hear and hope these may find all in good health together with my dear old brother and all the connection in that section but we have not the pleasure to say all is well with us but through the continued mercy of God we are all on foot but myself and wife are hardly able to attend to the concerns of life that necessarily requires our attention, our children and their families together with the family connection are in reasonable health at this time as far as we know, and people in general are reasonable healthy in our settlement with the exception of bad colds. You mentioned that you were doubtful that I had not recd. your other letter your reason for thinking so I have no doubt was my neglecting to reply to it sooner than I did which I hope you received quick after you wrote the one I now have at hand which I thought to have replied to before now but haveing nothing of importance to inform you of and my eyes being dim and hand old and trembling and my mind much impaired I have again deferred writing as soon as I aught to have done but from the above consideration I hope you will excuse my delay and not fail to write every opportunity and for the futer I think to be more prompt in my replies to you as respects the present presure of times with us I hope the most of people will rub through with out as much sacretise as was antisapated in the first of the alarm when almost every man was afraid to receive a bank note of any description, but of late, altho specie payment is with held, nearly every bank in the state is considered valied and their notes current in paying all debts. Crops in general has turned out better then was expected but nothing like full ones and people went in for so much cotton that corn is scarce and high say one dpillar pr bushel pork seven to eight dollars pr hundred and scarce at that cotton is selling from 9 to 10 and the highest 10-2/4 pr hundred, I hope I have corn and meet plenty for my family and shall be able by Christmas day to meet all the demands that is against me and lay in the necessary comforts of life for the next year without being in debt for them if so I aught to be satisfied and abundantly thankful to my kind benefactor who has preserved me and made my life his care for loe these 67 years if sustained till the 12th day of next month, in your next send me the exact age of you and your sister with your names in full and I will enter them in my book of record, now with regard to Religion in our State I would be glad to give you some of the meditations of my mind in a consise manner if I could, but am at a loss how to begin but in the first place there is great differences in the oppinions of many of the professors of Religion about the Mission and anth Mission Spirit some in favour and some against all the Benevolent opperations of the day in so much that many Churches and Associations and even to individual members are rending and deviding a sunder and declaring unfelloship one with another and it is hard to tel what will be the event but I do

firmly beleave there is utterly a fault among them for we are in so many places commanded to love one another and not to devour one another and for each one to be fully persuaded in his own mind puting away strife and devision from among them as such I think the word of truth condemns all such conduct and for my part I am for a Republican principle both in church and State and for all to have free privilege to think speak and act in the way that he fully beleaves to be right from the authority of Gods word, but not with standing the divisions that has and is taking place, several Churches with in my knowledge have of late and is now experiancing precious revivals and I hope my prayer to God is that by his over ruling providence order may come out of confusion and peace be restored to and preserved amonf Gods people of every name and order and them that are in error convinced of the wrong way they have taken and united with them that are in the right way and go on hand and heart together I must close my imperfect address haveing nothing more to add worth your attention and as it is more then likely we never shall be favormured with a personal interview in this world I think my hearts desire and earnest prayer is that God may grant you and yours me and mine grace to live to his praise in this world and to die in favour with him and in peace with all mankind and take us from all our sorrows and troubles to a life of everlasting Rest
