On a muster roll of a detachment. Company (L), 23d Mississippi Infantry, Confederate States Army, dated June 30, 1863, J. W. Hardy, private, Co. E, 20th Alabama Infantry, Confederate States Army, is reported "absent, sick hosp., Canton."

The records also show that J. W. Hardy, private, Company A, 20th Alabama Infantry, Confederate Stetes Army, was paroled May 2, 1865, at Salisbury, North Caroline, in accordance with the terms of the military convention of April 26, 1865.
