chine currently Regiment of Texas Cavalry served there
two months - this was about ^{a short time} ~~the~~ months before
the close of the war. Being under age my father
to M. Hightower
persuaded me to enlist in Capt Joe Terrell's co. In
Walker's Battalion I went to this company then in
Louisiana and served in that company those
two months; was in the battle of Yellow
Bayou with that co. helped to carry John Henderson
brother to Joe M. Henderson off the field, who
died from his wounds. They would ^{not} receive me in
that company because under age. I then re-
turned
to Sammt currently & joined Capt Wm. Quigley's
co about the close of the war and at San Antonio
I came back home & he went on to Mexico.
