AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:30 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the Vice-President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 159 Present, 8 Absent-excused, 14 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend William M. Harris, District Superintendent, Austin District, United Methodist Church offered the invocation.

On the fourth of June, concerning Article X, Section 13, related to bank holding companies, I voted "Yea" on the motion to table the Wilson amendment. However, my voting machine did not register my vote, and this was not discovered until June 5. Due to this fact, this entry into the official Journal of the Constitutional Convention is necessary.

Question: Shall Section 16 be adopted?

Amend Section 16 of Article X, the General Provisions Committee Report, by striking the remainder of the section after the word "principle" and substituting therefor a period (".").

The amendment was read.

Delegate Longoria moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 80 Yeas, 73 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 27 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Santiesteban and Washington who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Peveto offered the following amendment to Section 16, Article X:

Amend Article X, Section 16 by striking the section and substituting the following:

The operation of any lottery or gift enterprise or the sale of tickets in such an enterprise, whether established or existing in Texas or elsewhere, is against the public policy of the state and is prohibited. Penalties must be prescribed by law.

Submit the following in separate proposals to the voters of Texas, which, if either one or both are adopted by a majority of the electors voting on the question, shall amend Article X, Section 16 of the proposed constitution by denoting the above section as subsection (a) and adding subsections (b) and/or (c) thereto, or if (b) and/or (c) are

adopted by a majority of the electors voting on the question and the proposed constitution is not adopted, shall amend Article III, Section 47 of the Constitution of 1876, as amended, by denoting the present section as subsection (a) and by adding subsections (b) and/or (c) thereto to read:

(b) A lottery may be operated in the form of bingo or raffle if conducted by and for the benefit of a nonprofit charitable organization that has been in existence for at least three years and if the entire proceeds are expended in this state for the purposes of the nonprofit charitable organization. Operation of the enterprise must be limited to one location as provided by law.

(c) The operation of any parimutuel enterprise or the sale of tickets or other evidences of participation in such an enterprise, whether established or existing in Texas or elsewhere, is hereby declared to be against the public policy of the state and is prohibited. Penalties must be prescribed by law.

The amendment was read.

On motion of Delegate Peveto and by unanimous consent, the amendment was withdrawn.

Submit the following in separate proposals to the voters of Texas, which, if either one or both are adopted by a majority of the electors voting on the question, shall amend Article X, Section 16 of the proposed constitution by denoting the above section as subsection (a) and adding subsections (b) and/or (c) thereto, or if (b) and/or (c) are adopted by a majority of the electors voting on the question and the proposed constitution is not adopted, shall amend Article III, Section 47 of the Constitution of 1876, as amended, by denoting the present section as subsection (a) and by adding subsections (b) and/or (c) thereto to read:

(b) A lottery may be operated in the form of bingo or raffle if conducted by and for the benefit of a nonprofit charitable

organization that has been in existence for at least three years and if the entire proceeds are expended in this state for the purposes of the nonprofit charitable organization. Operation of the enterprise must be limited to one location as provided by law.

(c) The operation of any parimutuel enterprise or the sale of tickets or other evidences of participation in such an enterprise, whether established or existing in Texas or elsewhere, is hereby declared to be against the public policy of the state and is prohibited. Penalties must be prescribed by law.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 109 Yeas, 52 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 19 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

The Previous Question failed to be ordered by the following vote: 80 Yeas, 82 Nays.

Delegate Doyle requested a verification of Record 9. The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 82 Nays.

and submitting a separate proposal to the voters of Texas, which shall present the following as alternatives and, depending upon which is adopted by a majority of the electors voting on the question, shall amend Article X, Section 16 of the proposed constitution by adding a Subsection (c) thereto, to read:

(c) The operation of any parimutuel enterprise or the sale of tickets or other evidences of participation in such an enterprise in Texas is not against the public policy of the State unless prohibited by law.

(c) The operation of any parimutuel enterprise or the sale of tickets or other

(3) The amount to be contributed by persons participating in the Employees Retirement System of Texas and the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall be established by the legislature, and the amount contributed by the state shall be at least six percent of the aggregate compensation paid to the individuals participating in the system. If additional funds are actuarially determined to be required to fund benefits authorized by law, the legislature shall provide all projected costs of the benefits by appropriating all necessary additional funds, by increasing the rate of employee contributions, by increasing the state contribution, or by any combination of these methods.

Delegate Agnich offered the following amendment to Section 18 of Article X:

Amend Section 18, Section (a)(3) by striking everything after the word "system" on line 13, page 9 and insert "as provided by law."

On motion of Delegate Agnich, and by unanimous consent, the amendment was withdrawn.

Amend Committee Report Article X, Section 18, Subsection (d)(1) by striking the entire committee language of (d)(1) and substituting the following:

(d)(1) The system of retirement, disability and survivors' benefits established in the constitution or by law for justices, judges, and commissioners of the appellate courts and judges of the district and criminal district courts and in effect at the time of adoption hereof shall be continued; however, this system will be brought into compliance with other provisions of this section by the legislature within three years from the date of adoption of this section. The legislature shall provide for inclusion in the system of judges of all courts in the unified judicial system and such other judges of all courts in the unified judicial system and such other elected state officials as now or hereafter provided by law.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Doggett moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 114 Yeas, 25 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 41 Not Voting. (Record 19, Appendix)

Delegate Earle for Delegate Hale offered the following amendment to Section 18, Article X:

Amend Article X, Section 18 by deleting all of Subsection (d) and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

(d) Judicial Retirement System. (1) The legislature may prescribe by law the mandatory retirement age of a justice or

judge in the unified judicial system.

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution, the system of retirement, disability, and survivors benefits heretofore established in the Constitution or by law for justices, judges, and commissioners of the appellate courts and judges of the district and criminal district courts is continued in effect. The legislature shall provide for inclusion in the system of judges of all courts in the unified judicial system. Contributions required and benefits payable shall be as now or hereafter provided by law.

(3) General administration of the Judicial Retirement System of Texas shall be by the Board of Trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas under such regulations as may be provided by law.

The amendment was read and was adopted by the following vote: 92 Yeas, 47 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 39 Not Voting. (Record 20, Appendix)

Amend Article X, Section 18(a)(3) by striking the (.) period after the word "investments" and inserting:

"and as may be further restricted by law."

Section 19. AUTHORITY OF THE LEGISLATURE TO CLASSIFY LOANS AND LENDERS, LICENSE AND REGULATE LENDERS, DEFINE

June 6, 1974

INTEREST, AND FIX MAXIMUM RATES OF INTEREST; USURY; RATE OF INTEREST WHERE ABSENT IN CONTRACT; POWERS NONDELEGABLE. The legislature shall have the authority to classify loans and lenders, license and regulate lenders, define interest, and fix maximum rates of interest, not in excess of 10 percent per annum.

In the absence of legislation fixing maximum rates of interest, any rate of interest greater than 10 percent per annum shall be deemed usurious.

In contracts of any character where no rate of interest is agreed upon, the rate shall not exceed 6 percent per annum.

The powers of the legislature to classify loans and lenders, define interest, and fix maximum rates of interest shall not be subject to delegation by the legislature to any board or governmental agency.
