In the early part of 1863, joined Forest's Cavalry - Co F, (Halls) ^{Regt} 14 Tenn Cavalry (White) and saw service in this command until the surrender at Vicksburg. ^{May 9} 1863. Was in the Battle of Hurricane Creek - Miss - Memphis Tenn, Athens Ala, Sulphur Springs, Pulaski Tenn, Fayette Court House Ga.
