My first engagement in battle was at Murfreesboro Breckenridge Div and Pillow's Brigade (temporarily). The next engagement in Chickamauga in Brown Brigade. Steuart Div. and at Missionary Ridge served in the same Brigade and Division on May the 6th the day before the great one hundred days battles commenced from Dalton to Atlanta I received a detail from Gen G.E. Johnston to report to Atlanta and take charge of his new pontoon that he had just ~~had~~ erected there. so that severed my connexion with my Regiment untill the sad end, which terminated war. my reference is P.M. Lewis and H.R. Freeman of Horney Tex
