Hope Church, Peach Tree Creek, and all the Battles
around Atlanta & Jonesboro. Then in the
Campaign to Nashville and back was in
all the Battles of that Campaign. and
also at the Battle of Bentonville.
was slightly wounded at Frankens Forge
