Was in the following Battles first day of the seven days fight & the last one (to wit) Kings school house & Melrom Hill next Sharpsburg & Sheppertown. Wilderness. &c In sept 1863. was elected 1st Lieut of Co. E. Bonner's Battalion Siege artillery stationed in Fla, was in command of Co, at Ocean Pond Battle and was engaged in James Island, S.C, & last at Sumpter S.C, the day Gen R E Lee surrendered &c
