Born - in Cole county Missouri in ¹⁴⁹⁴1833 -
Came to Tarrant county in Decr 1844
and settled at Grapevine & have been there
ever since - am the oldest settler in
Tarrant county living at this date

When and where Enlisted - At Grapevine Texas in
1862 as a private in co A. Capt Davenport's

Company 1st Texas Cavalry after -
wards dismounted - Polk's brigade walking
division Trans. Miss & 1st ment - served till end of war

was in all the battles of my command, the
first capital battles being Mansfield & Yellow
Bayou - The command was disbanded in
Texas at close of the war below Houston.
