I first went into camps on or near the Manassas battle field in Virginia was in several Skirmishes but was not in any large Battle at the time of the 4 or 5 days Battle at Richmond Virginia I was Sick at the Hospital in the Spring of 1862 I changed from the 21st Georgia Regiment to the 10th Alabama Regiment Co - I Hood was Colonel and Bruten was Captain of Company C - at the time of the Gettysburg Battle I was with the Wagon Train - about a month before the War ended I got a 60 days Furlough and was at home when the War closed James R. when I started home from the army I got on the Train at Orange Court house in Virginia
