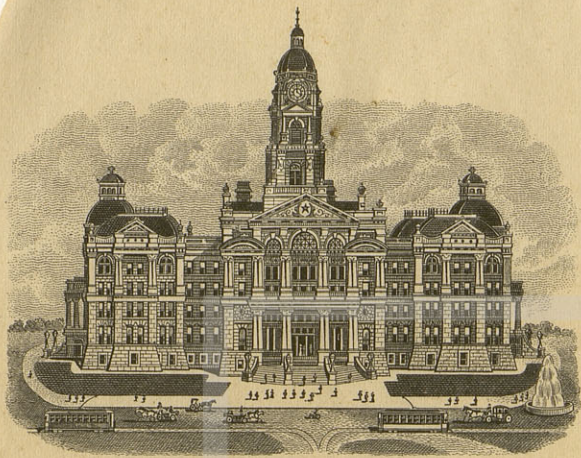

C. J. Laudrum was born June 15, 1837, Stone Mountain Decalb Co Georgia.

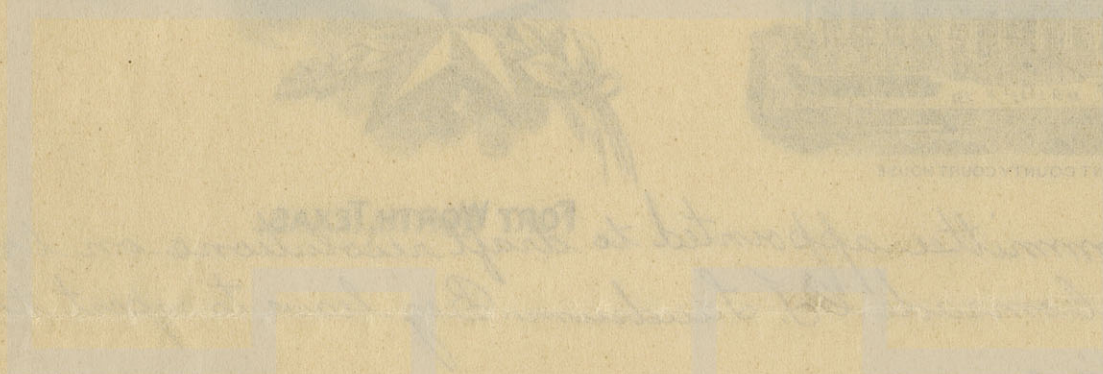
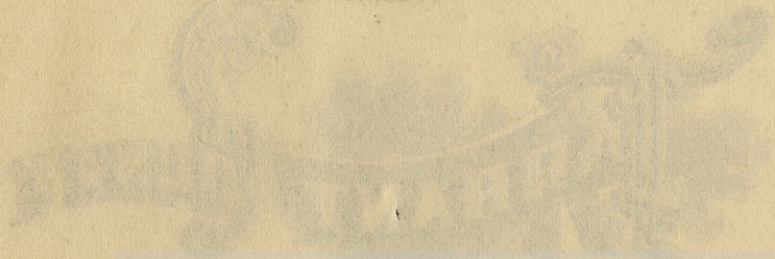
Married Nov 17, 1885 in Rome, Floyd Co. Georgia to Miss Addie Huffaker. She died June 12, 1894

He enlisted in the Confederate army April, 1861 in Company D 22 Ala. regiment Leas Brigade Woods Div, Papes Corps. Was in the following battles: Battles of Murfreesboro, Chickamauga, Missionary Ridge and he was captured at Missionary Ridge, was taken to

Rock Island prison and was exchanged in March 1865.

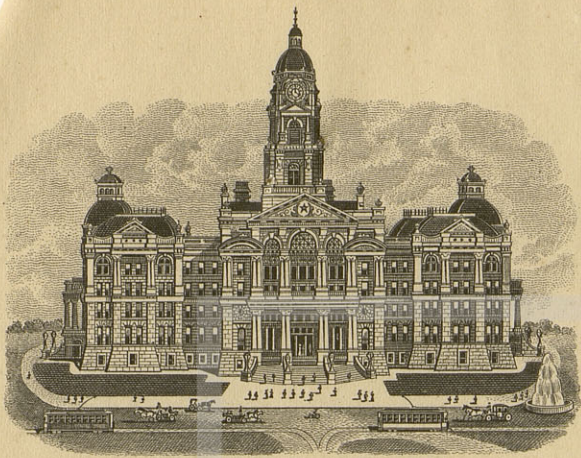

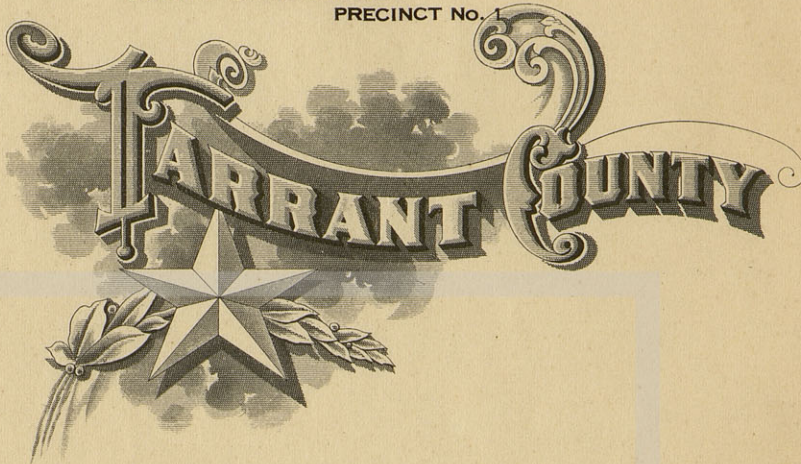

Soldier of Christ; Well done, praise be thy new employ.

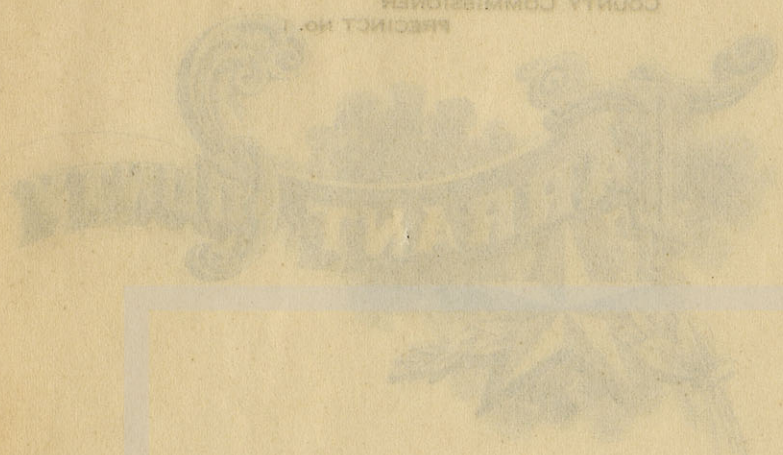
And while eternal ages run.

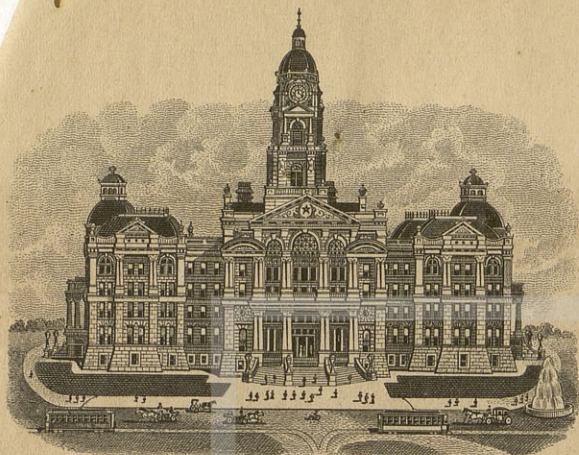
