AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:00 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 139 Present, 33 Absent-excused, 8 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend David L. Bulgerin, Pastor, St. Paul Evangelical Lutheran Church, Taylor, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Almighty God, from whose loving had we have received so many good and wonderful gifts, we thank Thee for this day, and for the opportunities that it provides. Particularly are we thankful for our beloved nation, and for this state, and for dedicated men and women who have chosen to offer themselves as public servants. Question: Shall Article IV as amended be adopted?

Delegate Traeger offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 13:

Amend Article IV, Section 13(a) by deleting the last sentence.

The amendment was read.

(Delegate Coleman in Chair)

Delegate Meier moved to table the amendment.

(President in Chair)

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 64 Yeas, 62 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 51 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

#### PAIRED VOTES

Delegate Hoestenbach (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate McKinnon (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Doyle (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Schwartz (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Calhoun requested a verification of Record Vote 2. The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 64 Yeas, 62 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 52 Not Voting.

#### DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Parker of Jefferson, Schwartz, Vecchio, Leland and Von Dohlen who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Mauzy who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Hale offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 13:

Amend Article IV, Section 13, by deleting Subsection (c) and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

(c) All orders and resolutions requiring the concurrence of both houses of the legislature shall be presented to the Governor. If the Governor disapproves an order or resolution, it shall not be effective unless repassed by both houses in the manner prescribed in Subsection (a) hereof. Presentation to the Governor shall not be required on orders or resolutions pertaining to (1) amendments to the State and federal constitutions, (2) referendums, (3) adjournments, (4) legislative rules, (5) investigations and studies, (6) internal administration, and (7) removal by address.

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Gaston explained Section 14.

There were no amendments offered to Section 14.

Delegate Sherman of Potter explained Section 15.

There were no amendments offered to Section 15.

Delegate Meier explained Section 16.

Delegate Meier offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 16:

Amend Article IV, Section 16 to read as follows:

The governor shall exercise those powers of fiscal control as provided by law [.] and [The governor] shall insure that items of appropriation for the executive branch shall be expended only as directed by the legislature [.] ~~except that~~ [However,] the legislature shall determine whether this power shall extend to elected officers of the executive department.

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Gaston offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 16:

Amend Article IV, Section 16 by deleting the following sentence:

However, the legislature shall determine whether this power shall extend to elected officers of the executive department.

The amendment was read.

Delegate McDonald of Hidalgo raised a Point of Order against further consideration of the amendment, stating that Article IV, Section 16 had previously been amended by Delegate Meier.

The President sustained the Point of Order.

On motion of Delegate Meier and by unanimous consent the vote by which his amendment was adopted was reconsidered (he having voted on the prevailing side).

Question: Shall the amendment by Delegate Meier be adopted?

The amendment was again adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Adams of Hardin explained Section 17.

#### DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Olson and Lee who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Von Dohlen offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend Article IV, Section 17, by striking the section and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

It shall be the duty of the governor to submit to the legislature in session on odd-numbered years a report on the efficiency of the organization of the executive branch and the governor may at that time, or from

time to time, submit to the legislature reorganization bills reassigning functions among or consolidating or abolishing any statutory state offices or state governmental agencies. Reorganization bills shall be considered by that legislature and, as accepted, amended, or substituted, brought to a vote of each house. Nothing in this section shall prevent administrative reorganization by the normal legislative process.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Gaston offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend the Von Dohlen amendment by striking the words "may at that time or" and insert the words "shall within two years of adoption of this Constitution and".

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Waters offered the following substitute for the Von Dohlen amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend Article IV as follows:

(1) Amend Section 17 to read as follows:

Sec. 17. ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS. (a) All executive and administrative offices, agencies, and instrumentalities of the executive branch (except for the office of governor and lieutenant governor) and their respective functions, powers, and duties, shall be allocated by law among and within not more than 20 principal departments, including departments headed by the officers designated in Section 1, so as to group them as far as practicable according to major purposes. Regulatory, quasi-judicial, and temporary agencies established by law may, but need not, be allocated within a principal department.

(b) The legislature shall by law prescribe the functions, powers, and duties of the principal departments and of all other agencies of the state and may from time to time reallocate offices, agencies, and instrumentalities among the principal departments, may increase, modify, diminish, or change their functions, powers, and duties and may assign new functions, powers, and duties to them; but the governor may make such changes in the allocation of offices, agencies, and instrumentalities among departments, and in the allocation of such functions, powers, and duties, as he considers necessary for efficient administration. If such changes affect existing law, they shall be set forth in executive orders, which shall be submitted to the legislature while it is in session, and shall become effective, and shall have the force of law, 60 days after submission or 60 days after the legislature can act as a deliberative body, whichever comes later, unless specifically modified or disapproved by a resolution of either house.

(2) Renumber Sections 18 through 26 as Sections 19 through 27 and add a new Section 18 to read as follows:

Sec. 18. APPOINTING POWER. (a) Except for the departments headed by an elective

executive officer, all departments of the state are under the supervision of the governor. Except as otherwise provided by law, each department must be headed by a single executive appointed by the governor subject to confirmation by the senate to hold office at the pleasure of the governor.

(b) The governor shall appoint, subject to confirmation by the senate, all officers provided for in this constitution or by law whose appointment or election is not otherwise provided. They hold office at the pleasure of the governor.

(c) If a vacancy occurs in an appointive office when the legislature is not in session, the governor shall appoint a qualified person to discharge the duties until the office is filled by appointment and confirmation.

(d) A person not confirmed by the senate for an office may not, except at its request, be nominated again for that office at the same session, or be appointed to that office when the legislature is not in session.

(3) Amend Section 2 by striking out subsections (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f).

The substitute for the amendment was read.

(Delegate Johnson in Chair)

Delegate Wyatt moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

Question on the adoption of the amendment by Delegate Gaston to the amendment by Delegate Von Dohlen, shall the amendment to the amendment to adopted?

On motion of Delegate Gaston and by unanimous consent, the amendment to the amendment was withdrawn.

On motion of Delegate Von Dohlen and by unanimous consent, the amendment was withdrawn.

Delegate Geiger offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend Article IV by deleting Section 17 and renumbering subsequent sections accordingly.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Meier moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 94 Yeas, 35 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 50 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

Delegate Clark offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend Section 17 by striking the second sentence and insert the following:

"Approval shall be by the normal legislative process".

The amendment was read.

#### DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Rodriguez who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Meier moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 78 Yeas, 55 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 45 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

#### PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Hoestenbach (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate McKinnon (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Gaston offered the following amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend Article IV, Section 17 to read as follows:

Section 17. ADMINISTRATIVE REORGANIZATION. The Governor shall submit to the Legislature within two years after the adoption of this Constitution and from time to time thereafter a written reorganization plan initiated by the Governor or upon the request of the Legislature reassigning functions among or consolidating or abolishing any statutory offices or state governmental agencies. Approval shall be by concurrent resolution, and only if approved by both houses of the legislature shall the plans take effect. Nothing in this article shall prevent the legislature from amending the governor's plan of reorganization nor prevent administrative reorganization by the normal legislative process.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Blanchard offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend the Gaston amendment by inserting the words:

"a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting" between the words "by" and "both houses" in the second sentence.

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Jones of Taylor offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article IV, Section 17:

Amend Gaston amendment to Section 17 of Article IV by striking the words "concurrent resolution" as they appear on line 7 and substituting therefor the word "bill".

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Meier moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 56 Yeas, 72 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 50 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Hutchison (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate McKinnon (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment, shall the amendment to the amendment be adopted?

The amendment to the amendment was then adopted by the following vote: 78 Yeas, 51 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 49 Not Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)
