NALER CEMETERY

JOSEPH NALER (1803-1882) MIGRATED TO THIS AREA FROM GEORGIA IN 1851. ORIGINALLY PART OF HIS LAND, THIS SITE WAS FIRST USED AS A CEMETERY IN 1863 FOR THE BURIAL OF HIS WIFE POLLY (PRUITT) (b. 1813). NALER DIED IN WACO AND WAS LATER REINTERRED HERE. THE BURIAL GROUND WAS CHARTERED IN 1900 AND A CEMETERY ASSOCIATION WAS ORGANIZED IN 1947. THE ORIGINAL 2-ACRE TRACT WAS LATER ENLARGED BY THE ADDITION OF ADJOINING LAND, THE FORMER SITE OF A CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH BUILDING. DEDICATED BEFORE THE FOUNDING OF MOODS, THE CEMETERY CONTAINS THE GRAVES OF MANY PIONEER SETTLERS.

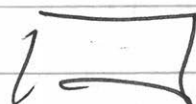
