**REMARKS**

I obtained a Transfer to Bragg's Army at Murfreesboro, Tenn. having a Brother there; I was in Capt. Wright's Battery, Preston's Brigade, Breckenridge's Division, Hardee's Corps. While there I was in the Battle of Murfreesboro. I expected to exchange with a man, who was to take my place in the Cavalry; but the exchange was not made and I returned to my original command & remained there until taken a prisoner & sent to Alton Ills from which I escaped but owing to sickness which wrecked my general health for some years I did not reach my command any more.

I was in many engagements; large & small; in Tennessee Kentucky Alabama, Mississippi & Georgia

I was one of the Four hundred with whom Forrest defeated & captured Straight & his command of two thousand in Georgia in 1863

I am a charter member of El Paso John Brown Camp at El Paso But have been away from this almost since its organization

I have been convicted on a charge of murder & served a part of a term in the penitentiary; was pardoned by Executive Clemency one year ago
