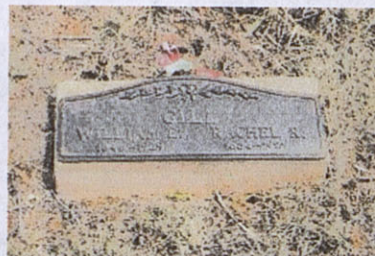

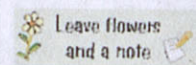

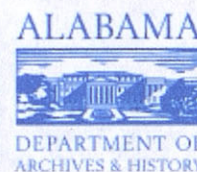

Jere Lawrence, being duly sworn, says: that he is 77 years of age and a resident of Merry Hill Township, Bertie County, N.C.; that prior to the civil war and during the civil war he resided in said Merry Hill Township, County and State aforesaid, and was well acquainted with W.E. Gill, who at that time and for many years after the war lived in this, Bertie County, State aforesaid, but who is now as he is advised and believes a resident of the State of Texas; that said Gill lived within about ten miles of this affiant during the war period and affiant saw him often and knows that he was detailed as community shoemaker and actually served as such for quite a while during said war. Affiant is not related to said W.E. Gill and has no interest in his claim for pension.

Soldier's Application for Confederate Pension

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

County of Dallam

I, Wm E. Hill, do hereby make application to the Commissioner of Pensions for a pension to be granted me under the Act passed by the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Texas, and approved April 7, 1913, on the following grounds:

I enlisted and served in the military service of the Confederate States during the war between the States of the United States and that I did not desert the Confederate service, but during the war I was loyal and true to my duty, and never at any time abandoned my post of duty in the said service; or (that I was in the service of the State of Texas during the war to protect said State against the Indians and Mexicans.

That I was honorably discharged or surrendered I was conscripted in the draft of 1863, men 40 and boys 19, and I was first sent to a depot where I was assigned to any company, but was called out as a guard of some local supplies. After this was sent back to make shoes for soldiers families. Every three months my father had to go (Give date and cause.) that I have been a bona fide citizen of this State since prior to January 1, A. D. 1910, and have been continuously since a citizen of the State of Texas. I do further state that I do not hold any National, State, city or county office which pays me a salary or fees of \$300.00 per annum, nor have I an income from any other employment or other source whatever which amounts to \$300.00 per annum, nor do I receive from any source whatever money or other means of support amounting in value to the sum of \$300.00 per annum, nor do I own in my own right, nor does any one hold in trust for my benefit or use, nor does my wife own, nor does any one hold in trust for my wife, estate or property, either real, personal or mixed, either in fee or for life, of the assessed value of over one thousand dollars, exclusive of a home of the value of not more than \$2000.00; nor do I receive any aid or pension from any other State of the United States, and I do further state that the answers given to the following questions are true:

1. What is your age? 81 yrs. and 4 mo.
2. Where were you born? Bartles County (Marshall Township) N.C.
3. How long have you resided in Texas? 37 yrs.
4. In what county do you reside? Dallam
5. How long have you resided in said county? 21 What is your postoffice address? Turkey
6. Have you applied for a pension under the Confederate pension law and been rejected? If rejected, state when and where not as much rejected, just didn't get at there
7. In what State was the command in which you served organized? Bartles Co. Winder, N.C.
8. How long did you serve? 2 yrs. Give, if possible, the date of enlistment and discharge conscripted in the spring of 1863 and discharged at the end of the war of 1865
9. What was the letter of your company, number of battalion, regiment or battery? not assigned to a company but served as a home guard.
10. If transferred from one command to another, give time of transfer, name of command and time of service transferred from home guard to his father as a shoemaker for soldiers families
11. What branch of the service did you enlist in—infantry, cavalry, artillery or navy? not no further than a conscript only as above stated.
12. What is the assessed value of your home, if you own a home? \$1000.
13. What is the assessed value of your other property? no other property.
14. Do you own any property other than that rendered for taxes in your county? If so, state value of same and county where located no other property.
15. Have you transferred to others any property of any kind for the purpose of becoming a beneficiary under this law? no

Wherefore your petitioner prays that his application for a pension be approved and such other proceedings be had in the premises as are required by law.
