# CONFEDERATE TENNESSEE TROOPS

## 8th Regiment, Tennessee Cavalry (Smith's)

### Overview:

8th (Baxter Smith's) Cavalry Regiment, usually called 4th Regiment, was organized in November, 1862, but annulled. Reorganized in January, 1863, by consolidating Davis' Tennessee Cavalry Battalion and four companies from Murray's Cavalry Regiment, its ten companies contained men recruited in the counties of Marshall, Sullivan, Smith, [Wilson](#), Cannon, Rutherford, Hamilton, Fentress, Davidson, DeKalb, and Sumner. Another company was added in August with men from Knox and Blount counties. The regiment served in Wharton's, Biddle's, Dibrell's, and T. Harrison's Brigade. It lost about 100 men skirmishing in Tennessee, then was active in the Battle of [Chickamauga](#). Later the unit moved with Wheeler to Middle Tennessee, was with Longstreet in East Tennessee, then returned to Georgia where it took part in the [Atlanta](#) Campaign. The unit continued the fight in East Tennessee and Virginia, and saw action in the campaign of the Carolinas. It surrendered with the Army of Tennessee. The field officers were Colonel Baxter Smith, Lieutenant Colonel Paul F. Anderson, and Major Willis S. Bledsoe.

# CONFEDERATE TENNESSEE TROOPS

## 1st Battalion, Tennessee Cavalry (McNairy's)

### Overview:

1st Cavalry Battalion was organized and mustered in to Confederate service in September, 1861. Its members were raised in Davidson, Williamson, Cannon, Wilson, DeKalb, and Rutherford counties. With five companies and 370 men, the unit moved to Kentucky and here confronted the Federals. Later it was active in Mississippi, then was reduced to three companies and in June, 1862, merged into Barteau's 22nd Tennessee Cavalry Regiment. Its commanders were Lieutenant Colonel Frank N. McNairy and Major Green Malcolm.
