AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 10:00 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 130 Present, 20 Absent-excused, 31 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend Howard Gates, Pastor, First Baptist Church, Manor, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

ARTICLE X ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article X.

Delegate Leland offered the following amendment to Article X:

Amend Article X (General Provisions) by adding a new section as follows:

RIGHT TO HEALTH CARE. Every person, is entitled to adequate, comprehensive health care.

The amendment was read.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegate Russell who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Reynolds moved to table the amendment.

The President announced the motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 61 Yeas, 60 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 61 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

Delegate Pentony offered the following amendment to Article X:

Sec. _____. (a) A county entitled to one or more congressional seats must be divided into the required number of districts. Population in excess of that required for complete districts within a county must be joined with population of another county or counties to form one or more districts. If the excess population is 50 per cent or more of a district such excess population shall be in one district.

(b) Congressional districts must not divide counties unless necessary to prevent a significant population variance between districts.

(c) If by final decree the Supreme Court of Texas or a federal court finds a redistricting plan enacted by the legislature to be invalid, the legislature shall enact a new redistricting plan according to the procedures set forth in Art. III, Sec. 5(e). If the legislature fails to enact a new redistricting plan, following the court's ruling of invalidity, the redistricting board shall draw a new plan according to the procedures set forth in Art. III, Sec. 5(f).

(d) This section shall apply following the 1980 census.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Reynolds raised a Point of Order against further consideration of the amendment stating it was improperly drawn.

The President sustained the Point of Order.

Delegate Geiger offered the following amendment to Article X:

Amend Article X by adding a new section as follows:

The people reserve to themselves the power to propose laws by petition and to enact the same at the polls independently of the legislature. This power is known as the initiative and shall be exercised in the manner provided for by law. No law which appropriates funds or which directly increases or decreases state or local revenues may be enacted by initiative.

Section _____. The legislature shall enact law disqualifying any person or the spouse of any person from appointment to any board, commission, department or agency of state government, who within the year preceding the appointment has undertaken for compensation to promote or oppose the passage of any legislation by the legislature or the approval or veto of legislation by the governor; and also disqualifying any person or the spouse of any person being in partnership with or having a substantial interest in any business or professional organization which has, for compensation, engaged in or employed for compensation a person to promote or oppose the passage of any legislation by the legislature or the approval or veto of legislation by the governor. The legislature shall also enact law prohibiting appointees of any board, commission, department or agency of state government from undertaking for compensation within the two year period after termination of service with the board, commission, department or agency to promote or oppose the passage of any legislation by the legislature or the approval or veto of any legislation by the governor.

Not more than \$11 billion in state funds may be appropriated from the treasury or spent from special fund accounts in any biennium, except that bonds or other evidences of indebtedness and the money to repay the principal and interest on the bonds, if approved by the qualified electors of the state as provided in Article VIII, Section 7, of this constitution, are not included in the limitation provided in this section.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Reynolds moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 92 Yeas, 35 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 52 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

ARTICLE X ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article X.

Delegate Jones of El Paso offered the following amendment to Article X:

Amend Article X by adding a section to read as follows:

Section ____ ACCESS TO PUBLIC INFORMATION. No person shall be deprived of the right to examine public records or to observe the deliberations of all agencies of state government and its political subdivisions, except as provided by general law.

No law which appropriates funds may be enacted by petition and a law enacted by petition which increases or decreases state or local revenues cannot go into effect until after the next odd-year session of the legislature.

Delegate Davis offered the following substitute for the amendment to the amendment:

Amend the Geiger Amendment by striking the section and substituting the following:

The people reserve to themselves the power to propose laws by petition and to enact the same at the polls independently of the legislature. This power is known as the initiative and shall be exercised in the manner and to the extent provided by law.

The substitute for the amendment to the amendment was read.

(Delegate Clower in Chair)

Delegate Williamson moved to table the substitute for the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

Question: Shall the amendment to the amendment be adopted?

(President in Chair)

Delegate Geiger moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 97 Yeas, 44 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 39 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

Question: Shall the amendment be adopted?

Delegate Bynum moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 66 Yeas, 84 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 29 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

Delegate Geiger moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 63 Yeas, 85 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 32 Not Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment, shall the amendment to the amendment be adopted?

The amendment to the amendment failed of adoption by the following vote: 73 Yeas, 73 Nays.

Delegate Peveto requested a verification of Record 10. The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 73 Nays.

By unanimous consent, verification of those voting "Yea" was dispensed with.

The President announced the vote as follows: 73 Yeas, 73 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 34 Not Voting. (Record 10, Appendix)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, shall the amendment be adopted?

Delegate Bynum offered the following amendment to the amendment:

Amend the Geiger amendment by adding the following:

"at least 20% of the registered voters voting in the preceeding General Election shall be required for the submission of any initiative."

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Geiger moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 64 Yeas, 87 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 29 Not Voting. (Record 11, Appendix)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment by Delegate Geiger as amended, shall the amendment be adopted?

Delegate Meier offered the following amendment to the amendment:

Amend the Geiger amendment by designating the language on the amendment "Section (A)" and adding the following as "Section (B)":

(b) It shall be unlawful to gather signatures on a petition for initiative and receive compensation for such service.

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment, shall the amendment as amended be adopted?

Delegate Geiger moved that his amendment as amended be Laid on the Table Subject to Call.

The motion was lost by the following vote: 57 Yeas, 93 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 29 Not Voting. (Record 14, Appendix)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment, the amendment to the amendment was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Meier offered the following amendment to the amendment:

Amend the Geiger amendment by designating the language on the amendment "Section (A)" and adding the following as "Section (C)":

(c) Once a proposition has been submitted to the voters as a result of a petition for initiative no shade or phase of the same proposition may be again submitted for four years after the election at which the proposition was voted on.

The amendment to the amendment was read and was adopted by the following vote: 94 Yeas, 54 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 32 Not

Voting, 32 Not Voting. (Record 15, Appendix)

Question: Shall the amendment as amended be adopted?

Delegate Simmons moved to postpone consideration of the amendment as amended by Delegate Geiger until July 30, 1974.

The motion to postpone was lost by the following vote: 41 Yeas, 108 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 30 Not Voting. (Record 16, Appendix)

Delegate Meier offered the following amendment to the amendment:

Amend the Geiger amendment by designating the language Section (A) and adding the following as Section ____:

____. It shall be unlawful to expend more than \$100,000 during any one calendar year by the proponents concerning any proposition being submitted to the voters at a consequence of a petition for initiative.

The amendment to the amendment was read.

The amendment to the amendment failed of adoption by the following vote: 74 Yeas, 79 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 27 Not Voting. (Record 17, Appendix)

Delegate Sullivant offered the following amendment to the amendment:

Amend the Geiger amendment by adding the following language:

Persons engaged in collecting signatures on a petition to propose a law shall be bonded in the same manner as district attorneys and shall further comply with all regulations required of registered lobbyists.

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Davis moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 103 Yeas, 47 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 30 Not Voting. (Record 18, Appendix)

Amend the Geiger amendment to Article X by adding the following language:

Delegate Davis moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a

REASON FOR VOTE

NEWTON

Had I been present I would have voted "Yea" on Record Vote 6.

I voted against the Vick amendment to Article X (Record Vote 8 on Saturday, June 8) because its adoption would have destroyed the boundary lines of all rural school districts and most urban school districts and, consequently, their ability to provide first class education. Further, the amendment was clearly in violation of federal law and the federal constitution. While I favor neighborhood schools and local control and would not support bussing of school children merely to achieve racial balance, I feel the Vick amendment was misleading in its effect and that it would have created more problems for our schools.
