E. corner of same Survey from which a Live Oak 9 inches bears N 4° 30' E 37 Ws. Live Oak 5 inches bears S 24° W 30 Ws. Thence crosses our creek—1900 Ws to the S. W. corner of No. 152. of an Alternate Series from which 18 inches bears N 64° W 17 Ws. Thence bears N 6° W 11 Ws. Thence to corner of same Survey from which a Live Oak bears S 33° 30' W 45 Ws. a Live Oak 10 inches bears N 37 1/2° W. Thence 11000 Ws crosses our creek—1800 Ws place of beginning.
