

This Indenture made and entered into this Twenty third day of August in the Year of Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Eight by and between Henry Hampton and Son & his Wife of the County of Greenup and State of Kentucky of the first part and William Hampton of the County and State aforesaid of the second part: Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of Two thousand Dollars to them in hand paid by the first said party of the second part the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained sold and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following described Real Estate situated in Grundy County and State of Missouri to wit: The North West quarter of Section Number thirty six (36) in Town Ship number Sixty three (63) in Range number Twenty five (25) also the East half of the South West quarter and the West half of the South East quarter of Section Number Twenty five (25) in Township Number Sixty three (63) Range Number Twenty five (25) containing in all Three Hundred and twenty Acres (320) be the same more or less to have and to hold the same with all and singular the rights privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever and the parties of the first part hereby covenant for themselves their heirs Executors and Administrators that they will warrant and forever defend the title to said premises and every ~~part~~ part

thereof against the claim or claims
of all and every person or persons claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
