It is an unhappy time for all concerned when a local or provisional League disbands. The case of the provisional League of Women Voters of Longview is no exception. The Longview League had accomplished much in the community, and the state board was always mindful of your diligent efforts.

At this time, we would like you to consider becoming a member-at-large (MAL). Members-at-large are members of the League of Women Voters who reside outside the area of, and are not enrolled in, a local League. Many members-at-large are former members of disbanded Leagues or former local League members who have moved to non-League communities. They receive the LWVUS VOTER, the LWV-Texas VOTER, other selected publications, Voters Service materials, periodic reports from the state League, and are notified of state conferences and other state League meetings.

The state board greatly values its members-at-large. There is still much League work and many activities in which they may take part, such as distributing state Voters Service and program materials, promoting the League, and lobbying their legislators. MAL dues are \$20.00 per year and are payable to the state office. Please use the attached form and enclosed return envelope. When we hear from you, we will send you the names of all those from Longview who choose to become members-at-large. Ten or more MALs in the same community can form a state unit, a viable option for Longview. We will be happy to assist you in forming such a unit.

Your group was a great asset to the League of Women Voters, and you demonstrated your ability to be an influence in your community. Someday you may again wish to have a local League in Longview. It would be helpful to continue your visibility in the community until that day comes. Meanwhile, the state League offers these alternatives and whatever assistance you might need. We look forward to hearing from you.

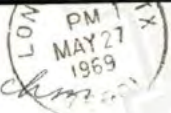
