The Dallas Cemetery is located in Bell County, Texas southwest of Holland, Texas on Hackberry Road. This 2-acre cemetery contains approximately 280 graves. A marker at the gate reads -

The first burial in the Dallas Cemetery was in 1849. At least 40 and possibly as many as 120 other burials took place here before Alexander James Dallas willed it as a cemetery upon his death in 1889. A.J. Dallas, as he is identified on his tombstone, was also known as Captain Dallas for his service in the Republic of Texas Army. In 1853, E.M. Pease, governor of Texas, granted Captain Dallas land in Milam District, Bell County. This land was on the Darrs Creek, about 14 miles southeast of Belton, Texas. Captain Dallas also purchased 160 acres from his father-in-law, James B. Wills, in August 1854. This land became the homestead of Captain Dallas. It was located west of Holland, Texas. The 2-acres of land, which is now the Dallas Cemetery, was a portion of this homestead.

The oldest marked grave in the cemetery is Elizabeth King Morris (8 December 1809 - died at 40 years of age). The grave is marked but the tombstone has been broken and parts of it are missing. It is hard, today, to see that this is the grave of Elizabeth Morris. Originally, the tombstone apparently had a statement "Wife of John A. Morris" after her name. That information and the date information are all that is left. The part of the tombstone with her name is gone. Earlier inventories, however, carried this grave as Elizabeth's and we have continued to do that in our database. The oldest person interred in a marked grave in the cemetery is Martin V. Parish (1842 - 1933) who was 91 years old when he died.

The cemetery is not in use but has a recently re-established cemetery association. The officers are:

There are about 80 unknown graves in the cemetery. Most of these are identified by a fieldstone; some have headstones, which have deteriorated and become unreadable over the years, and some of the graves are identifiable only by a depression in the ground.

From the first known burial in 1849, the number of burials per year in the Dallas Cemetery increased slowly each decade and peaked with 67 burials between 1890-1899. In 1896 and 1902 burials peaked at 10 burials a year in the cemetery. In the 50 years before 1890, there were 41 burials in the cemetery. During the 50 years from 1900 to 1949, there were 84 burials in the cemetery. The table below shows the number of burials by decade. This does not total to 278 graves because of the unknown graves.

There are six marked graves of veterans of various wars or conflicts of our nation. The earliest of these is James C. Armstrong (1816-1888); he was in the William Hart Company of the Republic of Texas Army, 1 Jun 1836-14 Nov 1837. A.J. Dallas (1820-1889) also served in the Republic of Texas Army and James Milton Fox (1838-1911) was a veteran of the Civil War. The table below shows some additional information on the veteran's graves.

Ten family names have five or more graves in the cemetery. The count includes males and females with the family name and females with that family name as a maiden name. These are shown below. This is not to imply that all persons with the same family name are related, only that they carry the same family name.

We gathered the information in this book in mid-2006, primarily from the headstones in the cemetery. Some additional information came from *The Story of Bell County Texas*, Bell County Historical Commission, 1988, republished in 1998. Rows in the cemetery were designated by us to assist in cataloging and mapping the cemetery. Some fenced lots exist and these are shown on the maps of the cemetery. Neither the row numbers nor the cemetery lots have any relation to actual property lines or to any sections or lots designated by the past caretakers or the current Dallas Cemetery Association.

The book contains an alphabetical listing of graves, a numerical listing of graves, and a map of the cemetery.

We are preparing a book and database of everyone buried in Bell County, Texas. We have personally visited 137 of the 170 known cemeteries in Bell County, Texas, but hardly a month goes by when we do not hear of another cemetery. In the interest of accuracy we encourage readers to bring errors in this listing to our attention. If you have or know someone who has additional historical information on the cemetery or people or families buried in the cemetery, we will include it in future books if you care to share it with us. Additionally, we would be interested in learning about other historic cemeteries in Bell County.

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Thaddeus W. Knight 1847-1893

Thaddeus W. Knight was born in 1847, just before his father's death, in Laurens County, South Carolina. He was the only son of Elford Leroy Knight (Feb. 9, 1825-Aug. 13, 1847) and Sarah A. Power (July 5, 1821-Mar. 2, 1896). Elford Leroy Knight was the oldest son of Silas L. Knight, a Baptist minister, (1804-1883) and Sallie Smith (1804-1868). After the death of Elford Leroy Knight, Sarah Power-Knight and Thaddeus moved into the home of her father, William L. Power (1850 Federal Census). In 1850, William L. Power obtained guardianship of Thaddeus. Sarah Power-Knight married William H. Garrett on Mar. 11, 1858 in Laurens County, South Carolina. They left South Carolina and their first child, Susan E. Garrett, was born in Washington County, Texas July 1, 1859.

William L. Garrett was a blacksmith and farmer, and passed the skills to his children, and stepson Thaddeus W. Knight. In 1862 William H. Garrett was shot and killed by a man with whom he had had a fence line quarrel. A man on horseback shouted "Hello" at the front gate. When Garrett went to the door he was shot and killed and the man rode on, never to be seen again. William's fourteen-year-old son, Joseph Madison Garrett (born May 12, 1848) swore to kill the man if he ever saw him again.

Thaddeus W. Knight married Sarah Celina Lowrey in Washington County, Texas on June 8, 1867; they lived in Lee County then moved to Bell County, Texas in 1878. He set up a blacksmith shop in Mountain Home, Texas. Mountain Home was about one and one-half miles east of the present town of Holland, Texas. Thaddeus invented an improved cotton and corn planter and patented it in 1892. In 1893, he took it in a wagon to demonstrate it to a potential buyer. As he was unloading the planter it fell from the wagon hitting him in the chest and he died about two hours later. Probate records in Bell County, Texas (Book J, page 202, Sept. 4, 1893) states that he died early in the year 1893.

Deed Records in Bell County, Texas reveal that T.W. and S.C. Knight bought and sold land in the Mountain Home (Holland, Texas) area. (Vol. 29, pages 499-500 9-7-1878; Vol. 32, page 566, 10-6-1879; Vol. 32, pages 370-371, 10-10-1879; Vol. 33, page 338, 9-12-1889; Vol. 33, pages 351, 352, 353, 354, 5-15-1880)

He was buried in a cemetery near the present town of Holland, Texas, known as the Dallas Cemetery. No gravestone was erected, but his grave is in the center of the cemetery, and the only grave surrounded by a wrought iron fence. During a historical restoration of graveyards in Bell County, Texas the Dallas cemetery was cleaned of the briars, brush, and trees that had covered it. Only one grave surrounded by a wrought iron fence was found, it is in the center of the graveyard. Descendents of Thaddeus W. Knight are claiming the grave, a marker has been prepared, and an application filed with the State of Texas Historical Commission for a State Historical Marker. ?

Oral family history is that Elford Leroy Knight had two silver Spanish coins in his possession at the time of his death. Thaddeus wore them around his neck all of his life. His only possession of his father.

I have the original patent of the cotton and corn planter and one of the coins.
