I was transferred to the Pay Master General's department at Little Rock Ark in Nov 1862 & returned to the command in January 1863 & continued with it until we were disbanded about 2 1/2 miles East of Henderside in Austin County Texas, on the - (I think the 5th) May, 1865.

I participated in the following Battles: Milliken's bend on the Mississippi River, Louisiana June 12th, 1863 & at Young's Ranch near Vicksburg late that evening.

I took part in the Battle of Mansfield, Louisiana April 8th 1864 at which I had my right leg broken between the ankle and knee - was shot in the right thigh & had my right hip shot out of place, after which I served as division clerk, until the end of the war.
