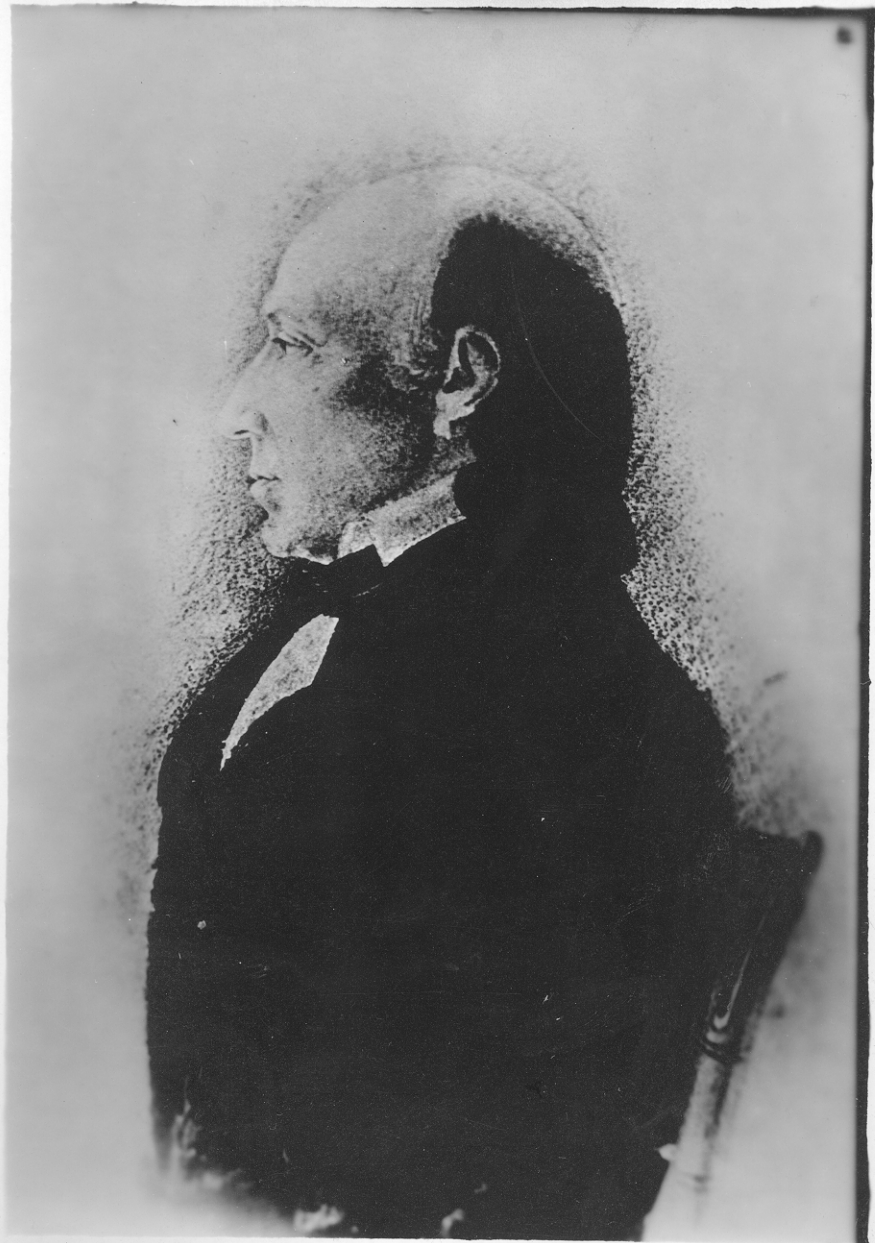
Frances Taylor Is Wed To Dr. J. Hampton Miller
