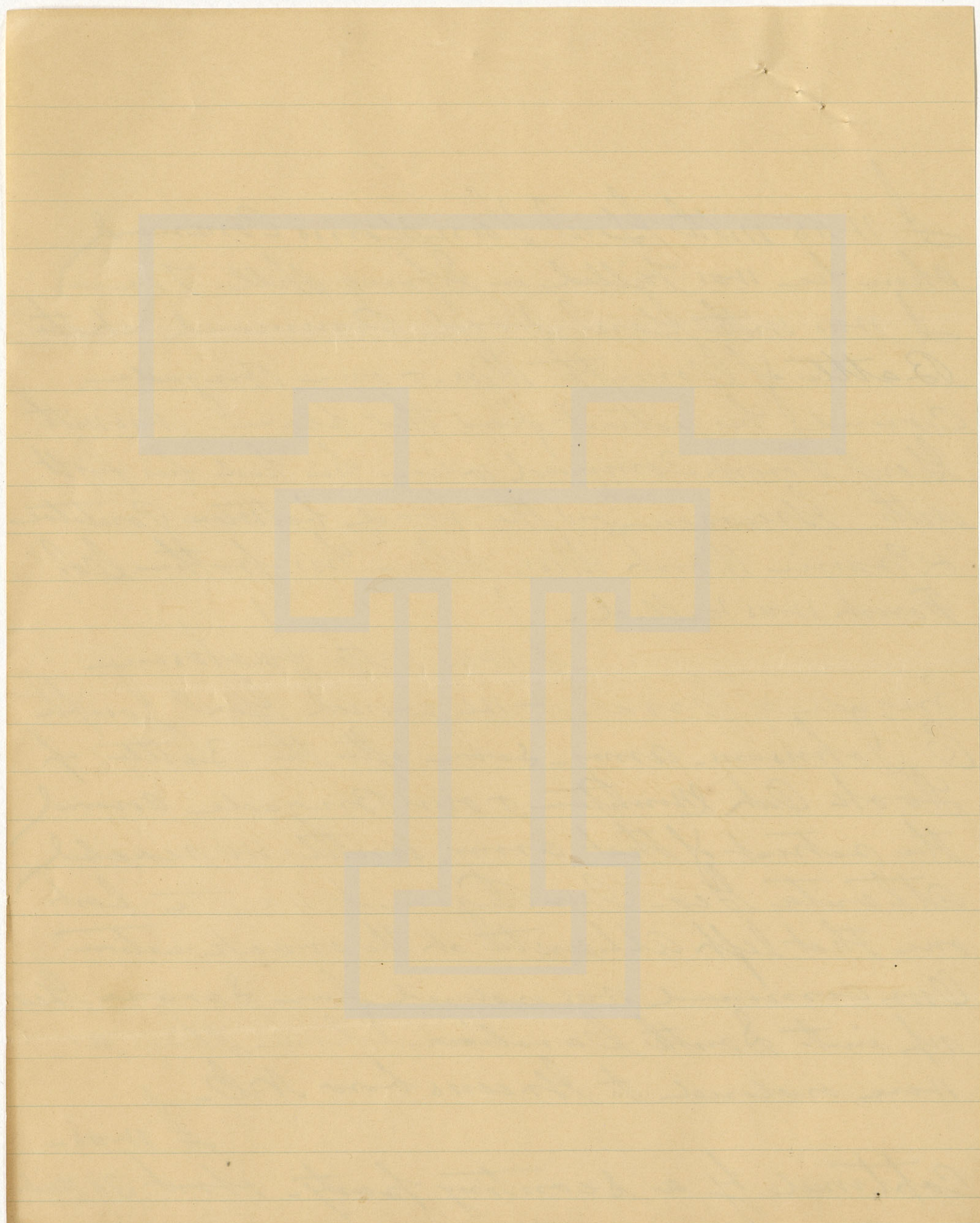


I was with Gen. Vandorn's Command
when he was killed in Spring Hill Tenn.
I was with Gen. Hood's Command at the
Battle of Corinth Miss. & our Brigade
covered his retreat from that place. Was with
Gen. Forest's Command when he had his fight
with ^{raid} Greason on the road between Pontotoc
& Prairie Month Miss. when his brother Col
Forest was killed.

I was with Jackson's
Brigade of Cavalry & we joined Gen. Joseph
E. Johnson's Army soon after the Battle of
Look Out Mountain & our Brigade covered
the retreat of that army, until we reached
Atlanta Geo. Our Regiment was the last
one that left Atlanta at the evacuation.
Our command was ordered from Sarana Geo
up into South Carolina & from there we
were ordered to Greensboro N.C.

I was -
Captured by a scouting party about 30 miles



Low Greensboro, at Salem - N.C. - a
few days after Gen. Lee's Surrender -
I did not know of the Surrender, until so
informed by the Officer commanding the scouting
party that captured me -
