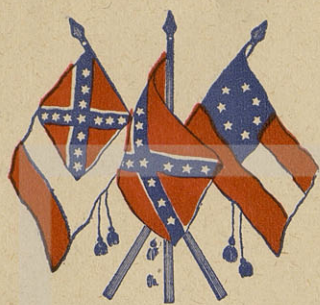

In 1862 entered the Medical Purveyors Department in Richmond Va in command of E W Johns Surg + Medical Purveyor C.S.A April 20th 1864 was ordered to report to Medical Purveyor Jas I Johnson at Charlotte N.C. Surrendered May 3rd 1865 to Maj Edw Walcott U.S.A. Special Commissioner.

My services were at all times in the Medical Purveyors Department C.S.A. and an active private in the Departmental Battalion C.S.A.

Left Baltimore City - Md Augt 10th 1861, crossed over to Va from Hancock Md to Bath Spring Va and from there to Richmond Va via Henrichester Virginia
