Dear Sir & Comrade

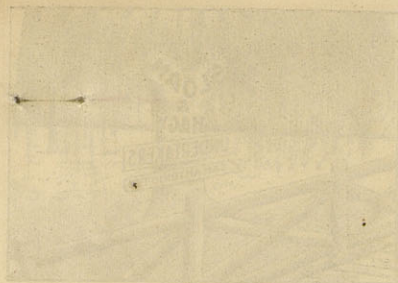
Your letter inquiring about
