AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:30 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the Vice-President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 163 Present, 5 Absent-excused, 12 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

(President in Chair)

The Reverend Charles A. Sumners, Rector, St. David's Episcopal Church, Austin, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Almighty God, our Heavenly Father, in these opening moments of this day in this historic Convention, we pause to acknowledge thy presence. Thou art the Creator and Sustainer of each one of us. Thou knowest our frailties, our strengths, our anxieties and our hopes. We humbly beseech Thee to direct the thinking, the speaking, the voting and all actions of each member. FISCAL ANALYSIS FOR MONTH
OF FEBRUARY 1974

The President submitted the following fiscal report:

TO: All Delegates to the Constitutional Convention of 1974

FROM: Price Daniel, Jr.

SUBJECT: Fiscal Analysis and Budget Justification for the Month of February 1974

In accordance with Section 5, Rule II of the Convention Rules, I am submitting to you the attached Fiscal Analysis showing Convention expenditures for the month of February 1974. Also attached is justification for these expenditures, cross-referenced to the figures in the Analysis by arabic numerals which appear in parentheses.

Since column one of the Analysis includes only cash disbursements during the month of February, some expenditure figures, such as delegate compensation (I.A.), reflect obligations which were incurred in January. Expenditures for February, in turn, will be shown on the statement for the month of March.

As can be seen on page 12 of the Fiscal Analysis, the Convention has expended to date slightly over \$600,000, which is about one-half of the sum originally projected to be used through February; however, it should be pointed out again that some expenses incurred in February actually will not be paid until March.

I hope you find this report helpful. Should you have questions concerning any of the figures, please do not hesitate to call on me or Jim Ray for explanation.

ARTICLE VIII ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article VIII.

Question: Shall Article VIII be adopted?

(Vice-President in Chair)

Delegate Caldwell explained the full report on Article VIII.

Delegate Doyle explained Section 1.

Delegate Evans offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 1:

Amend Article VIII, Section 1 by striking Section 1 and inserting in lieu thereof a new Section 1:

Section 1. TAXATION. Taxes shall be levied and collected by general law; provided and except, however, no ad valorem taxes shall be levied by the state.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 119 Yeas, 35 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 25 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

Delegate Jones of Taylor explained Section 2.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Sanchez, Waters, Wolff, Whitmire, Hernandez, Adams of Hardin and Allred, who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Blake offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Section 2(c) of Article VIII, by:
(1) striking "Each county" in the first sentence and substituting "The state"; and
(2) striking "county" in the second sentence and substituting "state".

The amendment was read.

Delegate Jones of Taylor moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Vecchio who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Delegate Peveto offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Article VIII, Section 2(c) by striking the period after "boundaries" and inserting the following: "according to general law."

The amendment was read.

On motion of Delegate Jones of Taylor the Convention at 11:47 o'clock a.m. took recess until 1:00 o'clock p.m. today.

AFTER RECESS

The President called the Convention to order at 1:00 o'clock p.m., pursuant to recess.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Schwartz was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Jones of Taylor.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Simmons, Denson and Williamson who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Question: Shall the amendment be adopted?

On motion of Delegate Peveto and by unanimous consent the amendment was withdrawn.

Delegate Caldwell offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Article VIII, Section 2(c) to read as follows:

(c) Each county shall provide for an appraisal of all taxable property within its boundaries. All taxing authorities imposing a tax on property within the county shall tax in proportion to this appraisal. The costs and expenses of the appraisal shall be allocated among the taxing authorities as shall be provided by general law. The legislature by general law may designate authorities other than the county to provide for the appraisal if the designated authority is no larger than the county and the appraisal is of all taxable property within the boundaries of the county.

Delegate Maloney offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article VIII, Section 2.

Amend the Peveto-Russell, et al., amendment by inserting the words "within the county" after the word "authorities" in the last sentence.

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment as amended, shall the amendment as amended be adopted?

Delegate Sullivant moved to table the amendment as amended.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 87 Yeas, 74 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 18 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

Delegate Peveto offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Article VIII, Section 2(c), by striking the period after "boundaries" and inserting the following: "unless otherwise provided by general law".

The amendment was read.

Delegate Doyle moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 110 Yeas, 44 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 25 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

Delegate Jones of Harris offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Strike all of Section 2(c) of Article VIII and substitute in lieu thereof the following:

(c) All taxable property in the State shall be assigned only one appraised value, and all taxing authorities imposing a tax on such property shall tax in proportion to this appraised value. The legislature shall implement this policy by means of local appraisal districts whose geographical boundaries shall be countywide; provided, however, that the governing bodies of such appraisal districts shall be authorized to contract one with another for the conduct of appraisal functions. The composition of the governing bodies of such appraisal districts shall be as provided by the legislature.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 79 Yeas, 82 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 18 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, shall the amendment be adopted?

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Poerner who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Blanchard offered the following substitute for the amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Article VIII, Section 2 by deleting Subsection (c) and renumbering other sections accordingly.

The substitute for the amendment was read.

Delegate Jones of Taylor moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment, shall the amendment be adopted?

Delegate Meier offered the following substitute for the amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Article VIII by striking Section 2(c) and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

2(c) There shall be provided for each county a single entity designated by law to make an appraisal of all taxable property within its boundaries.

All taxing authorities imposing a tax on property within the county shall tax in proportion to this appraisal. The costs and expenses of the appraisal shall be allocated among the taxing authorities as shall be provided by general law.

The substitute for the amendment was read.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Canales was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Sanchez.

Delegate Caldwell moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

Question again recurring on the adoption of the amendment, shall the amendment be adopted?

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Wolff was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Presnal.

The amendment failed of adoption by the following vote: 64 Yeas, 99 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 16 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

Delegate Hightower offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 2:

Amend Article VIII, Sec. 2, Subsection (d) by deleting the figure "10" and substituting the figure "25".

The amendment was read and failed of adoption by a non-record vote.

Delegate Sullivant explained Section 3.

(Delegate Temple in Chair)

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Bird was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Madla.

Delegate Blake offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 3:

Amend Section 3(a) of Article VIII, by striking the comma following "ranch purposes" and by striking "and by general law may prescribe separate formulas for the appraisal of land to promote the preservation of forest land devoted to timber production".

The amendment was read.

(President in Chair)

Delegate Parker of Denton moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 110 Yeas, 43 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 25 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

Delegate Garcia offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 3:

Amend Section 3(a) of Article VIII by striking same and substituting the following: Section 3(a). The legislature may by general law prescribe separate formulas for the appraisal of land to promote the preservation of open space land devoted to farm or ranch purposes and of forest land devoted to timber production.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Sullivant moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

Delegate Hale offered the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 3:

Amend Article VIII, Section 3(a), by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

Such formulas shall be limited to land owned by natural persons, Subchapter S Corporations, or trusts for the benefit of natural persons.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Sullivant moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

VOTES RECORDED

Delegate Temple requested to be recorded as voting "Present-Not Voting" on the motion to table the amendment.

Delegate Clayton requested to be recorded as voting "Present-Not Voting" on the motion to table the amendment.

Delegate Green of Harris requested to be recorded as voting "Nay" on motion to table the amendment.

Question: Shall Article VIII as amended be adopted?

The President laid before the Convention Finance Committee Minority Report Number 1.

BE IT PROPOSED,

That the following be inserted in Article VIII as a new Section 4 of the majority report and that the succeeding sections be renumbered:

Sec. 4. REFERENDUM ON INCOME TAXES. No law levying an income tax shall be valid unless ratified by a majority of the qualified electors of the state voting on the question at a general election.

Question: Shall the Minority Report be adopted?
