Carter of Lancaster County Surveyed Two thousand four Hundred & thirteen Acres of Land  
in y<sup>e</sup> County of Stafford which was never before Granted And return'd a Survey thereof Under the  
Hand of Thomas Gregg Gent.<sup>n</sup> Survey. of the Aforesaid County of Stafford Dated the 6.<sup>th</sup> day of No:  
vember 1695 But by some Accident a Deed hath never yett Issued for the said Land NOW  
KNOW YE That I for and in consideration of the Composition to me paid and the Annuall Rent  
hereafter Reserved Have Granted Made Over and confirm'd And by these presents Do Grant  
Make Over and Confirm Unto Thomas Carter Jun<sup>r</sup> the Son of the Aforesaid Thomas Carter the  
said Two thousand four Hundred and thirteen Acres of Land Situate Lying and being in the  
County of Stafford Aforesaid And bounded According to y<sup>e</sup> said Survey as followeth VIZ:  
On y<sup>e</sup> North side of Occaquan River and beginning at a marked Pickhickory standing at the upper  
end of y<sup>e</sup> Land of Robert Singleton three quarters of a mile above Sandy Run on y<sup>e</sup> River side, and  
extends thence North into y<sup>e</sup> Woods three Hundred & thirty Poles by a line of y<sup>e</sup> S. Singletons, then  
along another line of y<sup>e</sup> S. Singletons East Two Hundred & forty Poles to y<sup>e</sup> S. Sandy Run, then up y<sup>e</sup>  
said Run North two Hundred & fifty two Poles to a markt Spanish Oak standing by a fork of y<sup>e</sup>  
S. Run near an Indian path, thence still by y<sup>e</sup> Meanders of y<sup>e</sup> S. main Run North fifty six  
Degrees West four Hundred & ninety six poles to a markt Ash tree on y<sup>e</sup> Run then by a line  
of marked trees South thirty five Degrees West five Hundred & twenty Pole to a corner
