FIFTY-EIGHTH DAY
(Friday, April 5, 1974)

The Convention met at 9:55 o'clock a.m., pursuant to adjournment, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 155 Present, 8 Absent-excused, 17 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The President laid before the Convention:

C.C.R. 27, Authorizing the President to continue to commit available money for expenses of the Convention.

The resolution was read.

Delegate Hightower offered the following amendment to C.C.R. 27:

Amend C.C.R. 27 by striking the resolving clauses and substituting therefor the following:

RESOLVED, That the Convention utilize this unexpended balance and savings for Convention expenses during the period April 5 through May 6; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the President of the Convention, in accordance with the Rules of the Convention, be authorized to continue during the period April 5 through May 6 to commit an amount not to exceed \$150,000 from available money in the unexpended balance and savings in the budget adopted by the Convention in C.C.R. 16 for the purposes and functions specified in that budget.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Agnich offered the following amendment to the amendment to C.C.R. 27:

Amend the amendment to C.C.R. 27 by changing the period at the end of the Resolving Clause to a semicolon and adding the following:

"provided, however, that none of the funds which are authorized, or which may be authorized, for the use of the Texas Constitutional Convention shall be expended for the promotion or advertising of, or for travel expenses incurred by Members of the Convention or their staffs in advocating, the adoption or rejection of the Constitution proposed by the Texas Constitutional Convention or any part thereof."

The amendment to the amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

The amendment as amended was adopted by a non-record vote.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Santiesteban who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

The resolution as amended was adopted by the following vote: 114 Yeas, 29 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 34 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Wolff, Wyatt, Truan, Schieffer, Geiger, Head, Hudson, Williamson, Garcia, Vecchio, Lee and Vale who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

ARTICLE III ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article III with an amendment by Delegate Traeger pending.

Question: Shall the amendment be adopted?

On motion of Delegate Traeger, and by unanimous consent, the amendment was withdrawn.

Delegate Traeger offered the following amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Article III, Subsection (a) of Section 7 of the Legislative Committee Report to read as follows:

(a) The Legislature shall meet in regular session each year at such time as may be provided by law. Sessions in odd-numbered years shall not exceed 140 consecutive days duration. Sessions in even-numbered years shall not exceed 90 consecutive days duration and shall be limited to the consideration of appropriation bills, revenue bills, redistricting bills, executive reorganization bills, and matters submitted by the governor.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Clayton offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend the Traeger amendment to Article III, Section 7, Subsection (a) of the committee report by adding the word "non" in front of the word "consecutive" wherever it appears.

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Traeger moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Harris of Dallas and Von Dohlen who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegate Parker of Jefferson offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend the Traeger amendment to the committee report on Article III, Section 7, Subsection (a) by placing a period after the word "duration" on line 5, and striking the balance of the sentence.

The amendment to the amendment was read.

(Delegate Hale in Chair)

Delegate Traeger moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 76 Yeas, 90 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 13 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Canales who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment, shall the amendment to the amendment be adopted?

The amendment to the amendment was adopted by the following vote: 89 Yeas, 79 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 9 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Davis (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Reynolds (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Delegate Andujar offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Traeger amendment by deleting the number "90" and substitute the number "60".

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Clower moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate McKinnon was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Newton.

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Nugent who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Delegate Reyes offered the following amendment to the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend the Traeger amendment by striking

the figures "140" and insert the figures "180".

REYES
WEDDINGTON

The amendment to the amendment was read.

Delegate Traeger moved to table the amendment to the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 85 Yeas, 80 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 13 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

Delegate Gammage offered the following substitute for the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend the Committee Report, Article III, Section 7 by deleting the second sentence of Subsection (a).

The substitute for the amendment was read.

Delegate Scoggins moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 95 Yeas, 68 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 14 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Tupper (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Reynolds (absent), who would vote "Yea".

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Delegate Wolff was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Hanna.

Delegate Clayton offered the following substitute for the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Section 7 of Article III by striking Subsection (a) and substituting the following:

(a) The legislature shall meet annually in a regular session beginning on a date prescribed by law. During the regular session neither house may meet on more than 120 calendar days, which need not be consecutive.

The substitute for the amendment was read.

(President in Chair)

Delegate Traeger moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 92 Yeas, 75 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 12 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

Delegate Jones of Harris offered the following substitute for the amendment to

Article III, Section 7:

Amend Article III by striking Section 7 and substituting therefor the following:

Section 7. The Legislature shall meet in regular session each year at such time as may be provided by law and at other times when convened by the Governor; provided, however, that the regular session to be held in each odd-numbered year shall meet for a period not to exceed 180 days duration, and that the regular session to be held in each even-numbered year shall meet for a period not to exceed 60 days duration and shall be limited to the consideration of fiscal matters and such emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor; provided further that the even-numbered year session may be extended by the Governor for an additional period not to exceed thirty days.

The substitute for the amendment was read.

Delegate Weddington moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.

Delegate Lary offered the following substitute for the amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Subsection (a) of Section 7 of the Legislative Committee Report to read as follows:

(a) The Legislature shall meet in regular session each year at such time as may be provided by law. Sessions in odd-numbered years shall not exceed 160 consecutive days duration. Sessions in even-numbered years shall not exceed 90 consecutive days duration and shall be limited to the consideration of appropriation bills, revenue bills, redistricting bills and other matters approved for consideration by a 2/3 vote of the membership of each house.

The substitute for the amendment was read.

Delegate Weddington moved to table the substitute for the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by the following vote: 99 Yeas, 61 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 19 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment as amended, shall the amendment as amended be adopted?

Delegate Doyle moved to table the amendment as amended.

The motion to table was lost by the following vote: 81 Yeas, 81 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 17 Not Voting.

Delegate Williamson requested a verification of Record 9. The verification was ordered and reflected the following: 77 Yeas, 78 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 24 Not

Voting. (Record 9, Appendix)

LEAVES OF ABSENCE

Delegate Wyatt was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Adams of Hardin.

Delegate Braecklein was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Laney.

Question recurring on the adoption of the amendment as amended, shall the amendment as amended be adopted?

The amendment as amended was then adopted by the following vote: 84 Yeas, 75 Nays, 3 Present-Not Voting, 18 Not Voting. (Record 10, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTES

Delegate Davis (present), who would vote "Nay", with Delegate Reynolds (absent), who would vote "Yea".

Delegate Adams of Hardin (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Wyatt (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Delegate Jones of Taylor offered the following amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Section 7, Article III, Subsection (e), by striking the period at the end of Line 11, page 5, and adding the following: "or such other matters as may be presented by the Governor."

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Bynum offered the following amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Article III, Section 7(e) by inserting the words "other than those required to consider redistricting plans," after the words "Special sessions".

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Sullivant offered the following amendment to Article III, Section 7:

Amend Article III by adding a Subsection (f) to Section 7 to read as follows:

(f) If the Governor vetoes any bill within the last 10 days before adjournment of a legislative session or prevents a bill from becoming law by filing it with the Secretary of State with his objections within 20 days after the adjournment, the Legislature upon petition of a majority of the membership of each House may be convened on the first Monday following the 50th day after the date of the previous adjournment for a period of not more than 15 days for the sole purpose of reconsidering such bills for passage over veto.

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

Delegate Aikin moved that the Convention take recess until 2:00 o'clock p.m., May 6, 1974.

Delegate Massey made the substitute motion that the Convention take recess until 2:00 o'clock p.m., May 13, 1974.

Question first on the motion to take recess until 2:00 o'clock p.m., May 6, 1974, the motion was lost by the following vote: 78 Yeas, 80 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 21 Not Voting. (Record 11, Appendix)

Question next on the motion to take recess until 2:00 o'clock p.m., May 13, 1974, the motion was lost by the following vote: 66 Yeas, 93 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 20 Not Voting. (Record 12, Appendix)

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article III as amended.

Question: Shall Article III as amended be adopted?

Delegate Clayton explained Section 8 of Article III.
