AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 9:30 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the Vice-President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 143 Present, 21 Absent-excused, 17 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend Lanny Henninger, University Avenue Church of Christ, Austin, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Lord God: We have learned to play the game so well. We know what is expected of us. And how we must act. Confident. Wise. Certain. Yet often we are just the opposite. Unsure. Fearful. Tentative. While we are not eager for our constituents to learn it, we candidly confess to You our feet of clay, our cleverly disguised limitations, our ever present fallibility. Delegate Spurlock offered the following amendment to Article X:

Amend Article X by deleting all of Section 3.
