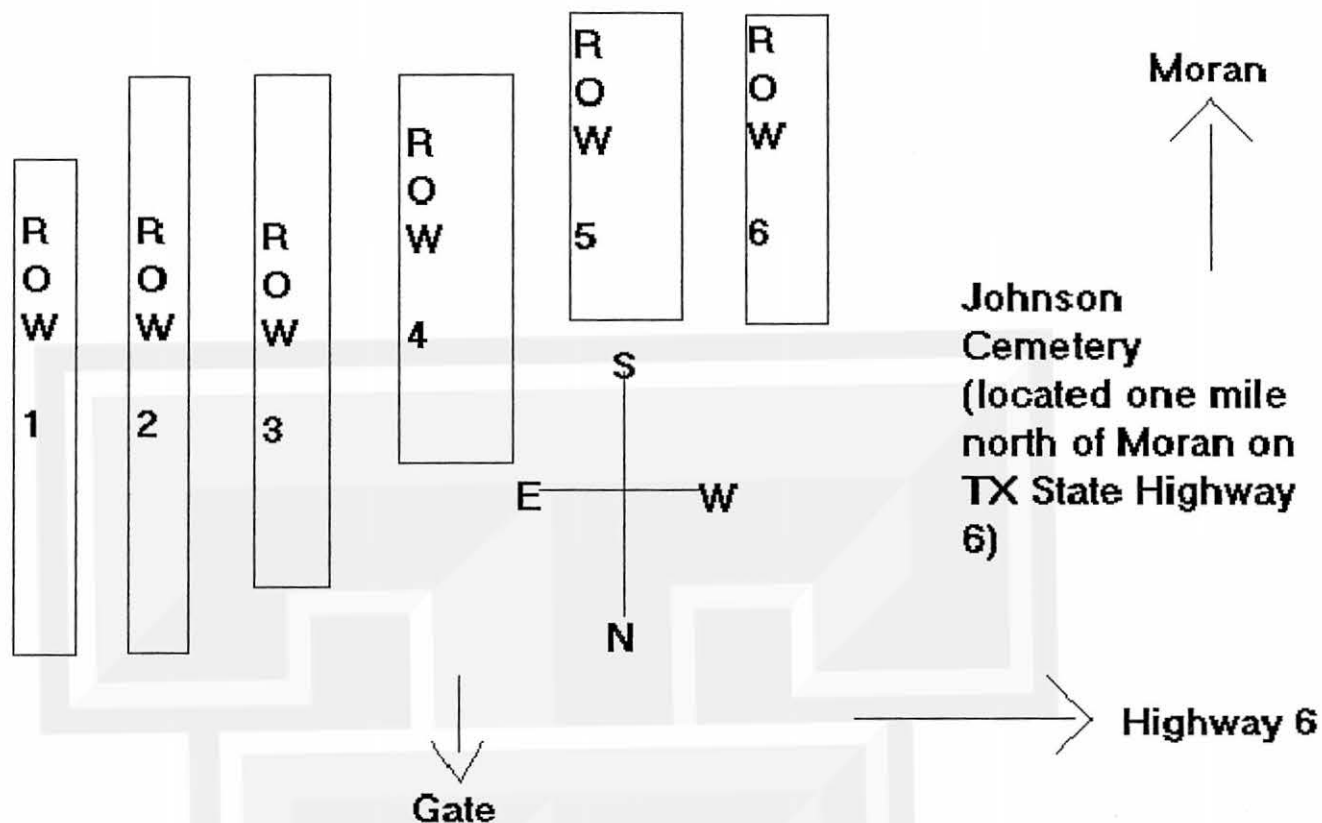

Johnson Cemetery is a small rural cemetery located about a mile north of Moran just east of Texas State Highway 6. The cemetery began in 1881 as the burial place of Rufus H. Johnson, infant son of George and Cynthia Johnson. George and Cynthia were early pioneer settlers of southeast Shackelford County. The land on which the cemetery now occupies was originally owned by Mr. and Mrs. Johnson. After the death of their son, the Johnsons donated the land as a cemetery for the area. Thus, it was named Johnson Cemetery. Currently, a fund has been established at People's State Bank in Moran for the continual upkeep of the cemetery. EACH ALPHABETICAL LISTING CONTAINS THE NAME OF THE DECEASED, THEIR DATE OF BIRTH (IF NOTED), THEIR DATE OF DEATH (IF NOTED), LOCATION OF THE GRAVE, WHETHER A BORDER SURROUNDS THE GRAVE, AND ADDITIONAL NOTES PERTAINING TO THE INDIVIDUAL BURIED OR THEIR GRAVEMARKER. A BORDER IS SOMETHING WHICH SETS THE GRAVE OR GRAVES APART, SUCH AS BEING SURROUNDED BY A CEMENT, STONE, OR BRICK BORDER. I HAVE DIVIDED THE CEMETERY INTO SIX ROWS, SHOWN ABOVE IN THE MAP. WALKING FROM NORTH TO SOUTH, THE LEGIBLE GRAVEMARKERS ARE NUMBERED IN EACH ROW. UNDER THE LOCATION COLUMN, FOR EXAMPLE, THE FIRST LEGIBLE GRAVEMARKER OF THE FIRST ROW WOULD BE READ AS R-1 (ROW 1), G-1 (GRAVEMARKER 1). IF A QUESTION MARK (?) APPEARS IN A LISTING, THIS MEANS THAT THE DATE IS UNKNOWN. IF A LINE (_____) APPEARS IN A DEATH LISTING, THIS MEANS THAT THE PERSON IS STILL LIVING. ALL NAMES THAT APPEAR IN GREEN ARE PERSONS WHO HAVE DIED IN 1999 OR 2000.

LUEDERS CEMETERY
(CLEAR FORK CEMETERY)
INDEXED & UPDATED BY BILL SIMPSON 1999

Lueders Cemetery, also known as Clear Fork Cemetery, is located on the Jones/Shackelford County Border at the southern end of County Road 203, approximately three miles south of Lueders. Lueders beginnings date back to 1899, when the Webb & Hill Land and Cattle Company sponsored a colony in the area, which quickly formed into a town. By 1902, a post office was established and the town was officially named Lueders, after Frederick Lueders, a Texas Revolution soldier. As soon as a town was started, naturally a town cemetery would follow. The cemetery was also called Clear Fork Cemetery because of its location near the Clear Fork of the Brazos River. The earliest known permanent grave markers date back to 1907, however there are several nonlegible stones that are most likely older than that. I would like to thank Bill Simpson
