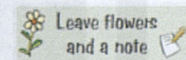

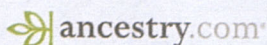

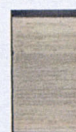

I, Mrs. Mary R. Thompson

do hereby make application for a pension, pursuant to the provisions of the First Section of Title 109, Revised Civil Statutes, 1925, providing for Confederate Pension, amended by Chapter 95, General Laws of the Fortieth Legislature, as amended by Senate Bill 287, Acts of the Regular Session of the Forty-first Legislature of the State of Texas, approved March 5, 1929, on the following ground:

I am a widow of Wiley Thompson deceased, who departed this life on the 22nd day of January, A. D. 1919, in the county of Hemphill in the State of TexasI have not remarried since the death of my said husband,* and I do solemnly swear that I was never divorced from my said husband, and that I never voluntarily abandoned him during his life, but remained his true, faithful and lawful wife up to the date of his death. I was married to him on the 19th day of May, A. D. 1869, in the county of Cherokee - - - in the State of Texas *My husband, the said Wiley Thompson, enlisted and served in the military service of the Confederate States during the war between the States of the United States and he did not desert the Confederate service. I have been a resident of the State of Texas since prior to January 1, A. D. 1920, and have been continuously since a citizen of the State of Texas. I do further state that I do not receive from any source whatever money or other means of support amounting in value above the sum of \$300.00 per annum, nor do I own in my own right, nor does anyone hold in trust for my benefit or use, estate or property, either real, personal or mixed, either in fee or for life, of the value of one thousand dollars, exclusive of the home of the value of not over \$2000; nor do I receive any aid or pension from any other State of the United States, and I do further state that the answers given to the following questions are true:

1. What is your age, and date of birth? 78 yrs. January 3rd, 1851
2. Where were you born? Rusk, Texas
3. How long have you resided in the State of Texas? 66 years
4. How long have you resided in the county of your present residence? 20 years
5. What is your postoffice address? Zybach, Texas, Care of Frank Ioung
6. Have you applied for a pension under the Confederate pension law and been rejected? Yes
If rejected, state when and where Hemphill County, Texas, 1919
7. Did your husband draw a pension? No If so, give his file number
8. Give, if possible, the postoffice address of your deceased husband at the time of his enlistment

9. What is your husband's full name? Wiley Thompson
10. In what State was your husband's command originally organized? Texas
11. How long did your husband serve? Four Years If known to you, give date of enlistment and discharge Do not know, but returned home June 1st 1865
12. What was the name or letter of the company, or number of the regiment in which your husband served? If he was transferred from one branch of service to another, give time of transfer, description of command and time of service. (If applicant's husband was a pensioner give his file number, which is evidence sufficient for proof of service.) 28th Texas Cavalry dismounted, Horace Randall's Regiment in 1861, Co. E, O. M. Doty's Co.

Name branch of service in which your husband served, whether infantry, cavalry, artillery, or the navy, or if commissioned as an officer by the President, his rank and line of duty, or if detailed for special service, under the law of conscription, the nature of such service, and time of service 1st Lt. of Co. 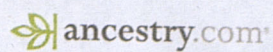

A statement of service was furnished the Comptroller December 4, 1919.

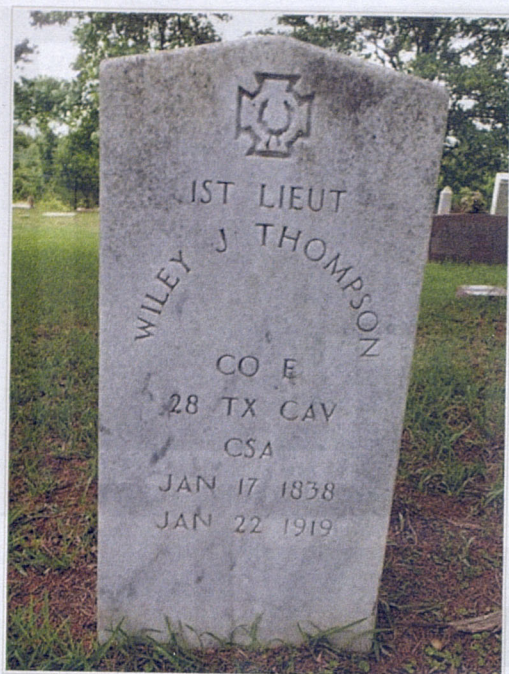

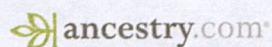

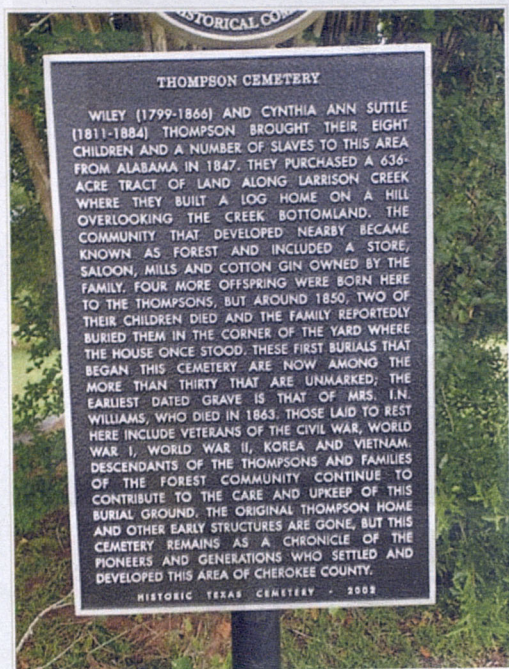

28th Regiment, Texas Cavalry (Randal's) (1st Texas Lancers)

Overview:

28th Cavalry Regiment was organized during the late spring of 1862 by Colonel H. Randal. It was formed with about 1,000 men and twelve companies, but one company was transferred to the 19th Texas Infantry Regiment in mid-1864. Some of its members were from Fairfield and Shelby Counties. The unit was soon dismounted and assigned to Polignac's, Randal's, and Maclay's Brigade, Trans-Mississippi Department, and was active in various conflicts in Louisiana and Arkansas. It saw some hard fighting at [Mansfield](#)
