REMARKS.

I enlisted at Yazoo City Miss March 1861 in the Hamer Rifles. Co D. 18th Miss Regt. Vols served untill Conscription was passed, got an honorable discharge for being under age. Came back home, and joined "Harvey Scouts" and did service as a scout untill close of the War. I was in all the engagements my Regt was in in Va up to the time I left it to wit, Bat Bull run July 18th 1861, Bat Manassas July 21, Bat Leesburgh on Balls Bluff Oct 31st 1861, went to Yorktown & was in front of M'Land and from there back to Richmond, and was in the seven days fight, got the Colors of my Regt at Malvern Hill & kept them untill discharged being then under 18 Yrs old. As a Scout, I was one of 9 sent to Nashville after Hood left Tennessee, & was the last one to return, bringing despatches to Genl Forrest at Oklauma Miss, from Mrs Overton, wife of Maj Overton of his Staff. My one of Johnsons army recollects Harvey Scouts in Georgia, We turned in over 600 prisoners. Run of 14 trains, Burnt 7 trains & destroyed Bridges, Warehouses on R.R. in Rear of Sherman & did various & sundry other things. I give as reference, any of Barke's deas Brigade & Harvey Scouts
