(Tuesday, May 28, 1974)

AFTER RECESS

The Convention met at 2:00 o'clock p.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 141 Present, 12 Absent-excused, 28 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

The Reverend Hulon W. Hood, Pastor, First Assembly of God Church, Mesquite, Texas, offered the invocation as follows:

Our Father which art in Heaven. Hallowed be thy name. Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

Thou hast exhorted us in thy word that we should pray for all men, for kings, and for all that are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all Godliness and honesty.

Thus we pray for our Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and the President of this Convention, and for all the members of our Texas Legislature and their staff, particularly at this time when this body is rewriting the Constitution of our State.

The word again says "if any man lack wisdom let him ask of God who giveth to every man as He wills. We ask for that wisdom today and for guidance as this body deliberates the issues that are before them.

And this we ask in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

Delegate Vick was granted leave of absence for today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Jones of El Paso.

Delegate Hall of Webb was granted leave of absence for today on account of transportation problems on motion of Delegate Grant.

Delegate Scoggins was granted leave of absence for today on account of compassionate reasons on motion of Delegate Spurlock.

Delegate Tupper was granted leave of absence for today on account of transportation problems on motion of Delegate Bigham.

ARTICLE X ON SECOND READING

The President laid before the Convention as unfinished business Article X.

Delegate Gammage moved to suspend all necessary rules to divide the question on Article X, and that all sections previously considered by the Convention be voted upon at this time.

The motion prevailed by the following vote: 117 Yeas, 18 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 45 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Truan who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Question on adoption of Section 1, Section 1 was adopted by the following vote: 126 Yeas, 2 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 52 Not Voting. (Record 3, Appendix)

DELEGATE PRESENT

Delegate Davis who had previously been recorded as "Absent" was announced "Present".

Question on adoption of Section 2 as amended, Section 2 as amended was adopted by the following vote: 131 Yeas, 2 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 47 Not Voting. (Record 4, Appendix)

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegate Powers who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" was announced "Present".

Pentony and Reynolds who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Question on adoption of Section 3, Section 3 was adopted by the following vote: 101 Yeas, 37 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 42 Not Voting. (Record 5, Appendix)

REASON FOR VOTE

I voted against Article X, Section 3, because it is redundant, ambiguous and mere surplusage. There is a conflict between the words "Residence" in the title and "suffrage" in the body of the section. This section is statutory and does not belong in the state constitution.

WILLIS

Question on adoption of Section 4, shall Section 4 be adopted?

Delegate Von Dohlen offered the following amendment to Section 4 of Article X:

Amend Section 4 to read as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in this Constitution, elections to fill vacancies in office shall be for the remainder of the term only.

VON DOHLEN GAMMAGE

The amendment was read and was adopted by a non-record vote.

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Semos and Blake who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Question on adoption of Section 4 as amended, Section 4 as amended was adopted by the following vote: 139 Yeas, 4 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 37 Not Voting. (Record 6, Appendix)

DELEGATES PRESENT

Delegates Baker, Waters, Coleman, McKnight, Simmons, Whitehead, Lee and Hoestenbach who had previously been recorded as "Absent" were announced "Present".

Delegates Tupper and Hall of Webb who had previously been recorded as "Absent-excused" were announced "Present".

Delegate Miller was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate Harris of Galveston.

Delegate Ogg was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of illness on motion of Delegate Green of Navarro.

Delegate Moore was granted leave of absence for the remainder of today on account of important business on motion of Delegate McKnight.

Delegate Wilson explained Section 5 of Article X.

Delegate Kaster offered the following amendment to Section 5 of Article X:

Amend Article X by striking Section 5 in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 5. DISQUALIFICATION FROM CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICE. Unless the procedure for removal from office is otherwise provided in this constitution, grounds and procedures for the disqualification, suspension, and removal from any constitutional office, and the temporary filling of vacancies shall be as provided by law.

The amendment was read and was adopted by the following vote: 94 Yeas, 55 Nays, 2 Present-Not Voting, 30 Not Voting. (Record 7, Appendix)

PAIRED VOTE

Delegate Jones of Taylor (present), who would vote "Yea", with Delegate Schwartz (absent), who would vote "Nay".

Section 5 as amended was then adopted by the following vote: 143 Yeas, 9 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 28 Not Voting. (Record 8, Appendix)

(Delegate Foreman in Chair)

Delegates Lewis and Reynolds explained Section 6 of Article X.

(President in Chair)

The President laid before the Convention Minority Report Number 2.

BE IT PROPOSED,

(1) That the following be substituted for that portion of Article X, Section 6 before the words "the conservation":

ARTICLE X

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 6. ENVIRONMENT. State agencies and political subdivisions shall act as trustees to conserve and maintain for the benefit of all the people the beach, park, historic site, air, and water resources and other resources designated by law. Every person has a fundamental right to protect these resources from pollution, impairment, or destruction, enforceable against any party, governmental or private, subject to reasonable limitations as may be provided by law.

(2) That the balance of Section 6, now beginning "The conservation," be renumbered as Section 7 with the title of NATURAL RESOURCES and that succeeding sections be renumbered accordingly.

BE IT PROPOSED,

(1) That the following be substituted for that portion of Article X, Section 6 before the words "the conservation":

ARTICLE X

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 6. PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT. It is the public policy of the State to protect the quality of the natural environment in Texas, and the legislature shall provide by law for the implementation and enforcement of this policy. In pursuance thereof, state agencies and political subdivisions shall act as trustees to conserve and maintain for the benefit of present and future generations the public lands, beaches, state parks, and historic sites, the air and surface water resources, and other public natural resources designated by law.

(2) That the balance of Section 6, now beginning "The conservation," be renumbered as Section 7 with the title of NATURAL RESOURCES and that succeeding sections be renumbered accordingly.

Amend Article X, Section 6 by adding a new paragraph appropriately numbered:

_____. SMOKING. In order to protect the public health from the dangerous effects of tobacco smoke, the legislature shall pass appropriate general laws to protect persons who do not wish to be exposed to tobacco smoke from the deleterious effects of breathing the smoke.

Delegate Salem offered the following amendment to Section 6, Article X:

Amend Article X, Section 6, by deleting the semi-colon after the word purposes and by adding a period in lieu thereof. Then add the following:

No waste material toxic materials of garbage in any form shall be brought into the State of Texas for the purposes of dumping or disposing thereof in any way in this state, and the legislature shall pass all such laws as may be appropriate thereto.

The amendment was read.

Delegate Lewis moved to table the amendment.

The motion to table prevailed by a non-record vote.
