the Knox County Veterans War Memorial as Civil War.

Baptiste Adrian Dugat b 1836 in Louisiana Enlisted in 1863 in Chambers County Texas
in the Company D. of the Texas Conscripts infantry. Death date is unknown. Wife Helen
M. (Stubbs) married in 1868 in Chambers Texas.

John Johnson b 10-29-1826 in Madison Co. Ohio d 8-31-1911. Wife was Harriet
(McRea) married 1856 in San Marcos Texas. He was a Captain in Company A of the 15th
Texas Cavalry.

Josiah Willis Norris b Feb 1831 in Georgia d. 4-19-1911. Wife Matilda A. (Still).
Marriage in Chambers Co. Alabama 11-24-1853. He was a Private in Company J of the
37th Alabama Infantry. Knox Co. Pension #26551. Was a Prisoner of War in Vicksburg
in 1863. Paroled in July 1863. ***He has no known location in this cemetery.***

(Braddock) 1838-1906. He was a Private in Company A of the 13th South Carolina
Infantry.

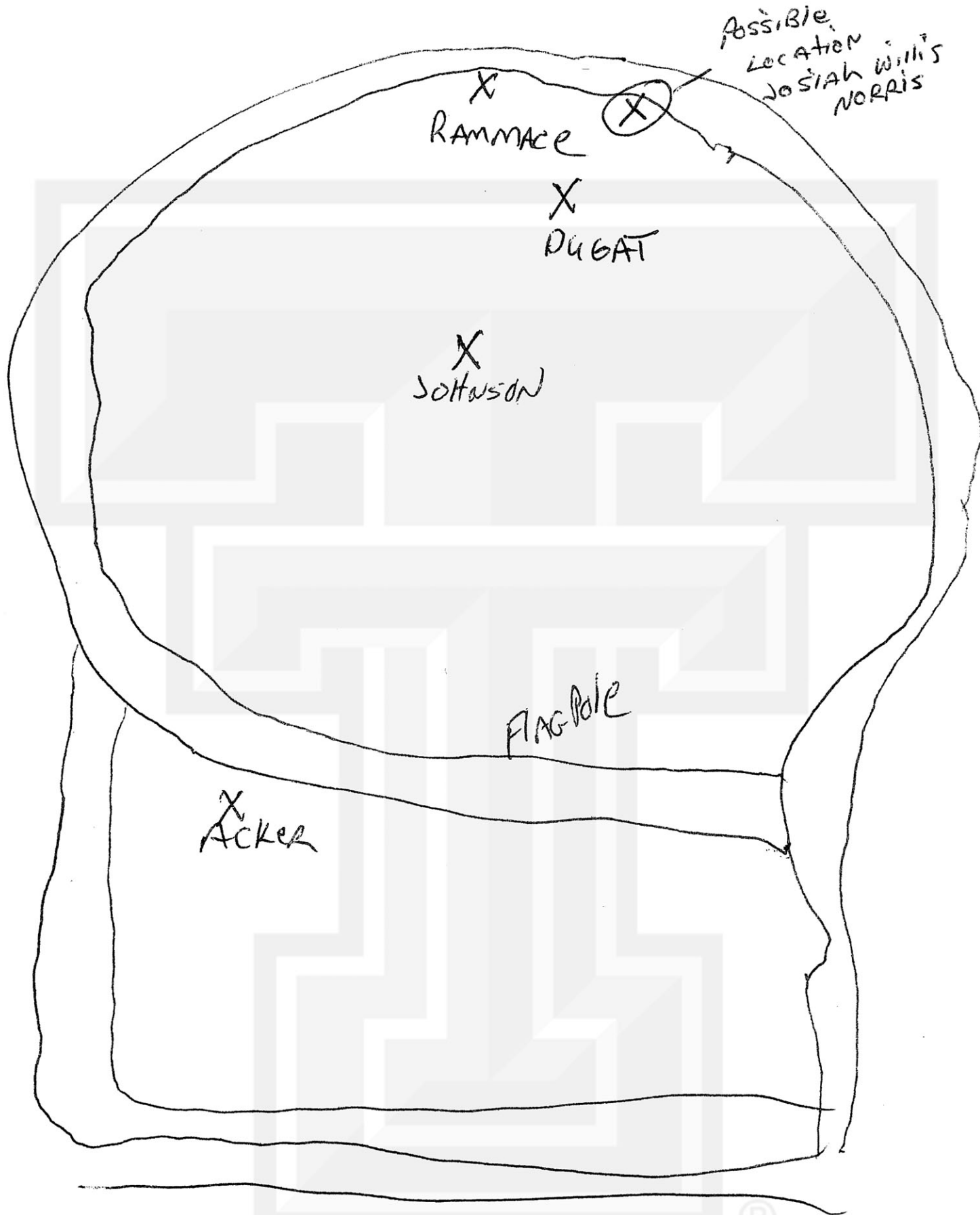
