Dear R. L. -

Your wire of the 30th inst. to hand - contents thereof a surprise to me. When you were here, we had a thorough understanding about this matter, which was to the effect that no cattle were to be put in Woody by anyone, and that you had a lease on the Weaver land by reason of his not notifying you of the cancellation of the yearly lease prior to the time of its expiration; acting under the assumption that the lease was renewed, you had made arrangements to use the land for another year, as you had done for the past three years.

It does seem to me that the cattle could have been kept out of your pasture, and let Mr. Weaver bring the suit, if the suit had to be brought. As it is now, the burden is on you to establish your claim; as it was, you were in possession of the land under your lease, and had a perfect right to hold it as I told you to do, but Weaver has just put his cattle in on top of you and taken possession, which puts us to some little disadvantage.
