Private George Washington Avent was 17 years old when he was enrolled in the Army of the Confederate States of America, 31 Jul 1861, at Oxford, Amite, Mississippi by Capt. James F Smith. He was five feet ten inches tall, had grey eyes, dark complexion, and light hair. His "Company Muster-in Rool", dated 22 Aug 1861, luka, Mississippi reveals that he was inducted as a Private into Capt. Smith's Company of Mississippi volunteers. His enlistment was for the duration of the ward for 3 years. His "Company Muster Rolls" shwo that he remained a Private in Company H, 22 Regiment, Mississippi Infantry. George Washington Avent was sick in the spring of 1862 and again in the fall of 1862. In March he was "absent on sick leave since 15 Mar 1862, sent to Oxford Hospital." Again on 23 Mar 1862, he was in the 1st Mississippi C.S.A. Hospital, Jackson, Mississippi with complaint of diarrhea. The his Sep-Oct Muster Roll shows that he was absent. He was present at the musters in 1863-1864. 9 May 1865 George Washington Avent, Pvt. 22 Reg't, Miss Inf, appears on a register of Prisoners of War at Memphis, Shelby, Tennessee--Deserters from rebel Army, Place of residence Lafayette, Mississippi. 9 May 1865, his name "Appears on an Oath of Allegiance to the United States sworn to a Memphis, Shelby, Tennessee from May 1-15, 1865.

Lived to see the movie, "Gone With The Wind", and said that the burning of Atlanta was as he remembered it. He and his brother, Amos, walked to Texas from Georgia as bodyguards to the Hensley family. The Hensleys had 3 wagons. They settled in Tyler, Texas, and went to work for John Smith, who had a barrel and chair factory. Amos married one of John Smith's daughters, Sallie, in 1868. John moved to the Bayless estate and rented land to farm. There he married Sarah Eliza Bayless. He attended the Gettysburg Reunion in 1938.

Private George Washington Avent was 17 years old when he was enrolled in the Army of the Confederate States of America, 31 Jul 1861, at Oxford, Amite, Mississippi by Capt. James F Smith. He was five feet ten inches tall, had grey eyes, dark complexion, and light hair. His "Company Muster-in Rool", dated 22 Aug 1861, luka, Mississippi reveals that he was inducted as a Private into Capt. Smith's Company of Mississippi volunteers. His enlistment was for the duration of the war for 3 years. His "Company Muster Rolls" show that he remained a Private in Company H, 22 Regiment, Mississippi Infantry. George Washington Avent was sick in the spring of 1862 and again in the fall of 1862. In March he was "absent on sick leave since 15 Mar 1862, sent to Oxford Hospital." Again on 23 Mar 1862, he was in the 1st Mississippi C.S.A. Hospital, Jackson, Mississippi with complaint of diarrhea. The his Sep-Oct Muster Roll shows that he was absent. He was present at the musters in 1863-1864. 9 May 1865 George Washington Avent, Pvt. 22 Reg't, Miss Inf, appears on a register of Prisoners of War at Memphis, Shelby, Tennessee--Deserters from rebel Army, Place of residence Lafayette, Mississippi. 9 May 1865, his name "Appears on an Oath of Allegiance to the United States sworn to a Memphis, Shelby, Tennessee from May 1-15, 1865.

John moved to the Bayless estate and rented land to farm. There he married Sarah Eliza Bayless. He attended the Gettysburg Reunion in 1938.
