There is a green grocer living here in our village whom I do not like. Once during Ramazan he saw me smoking a cigarette. Just as soon as he noticed that, he said to me, "What are you doing? This is Ramazan, and you are committing a sin in desecrating Ramazan!"

I answered, "Well, it is only one Ramazan. Next year there will be another Ramazan, and every year after that there will also be one, but when I go, when I die, I shall never return."²

The green grocer continued to criticize me. He said, "Allah will not forgive you! You have to prepare yourself in this world for living in the next world. Allah knows what you

I couldn't stand his talk any longer, and I couldn't resist saying something that would shock him. This is what I said: "Oh, uncle, you probably wanted to say that Allah does not exist at all, but you just did not have enough courage to do so."
