**AFTER RECESS**

The Convention met at 9:00 o'clock a.m., pursuant to recess, and was called to order by the Vice-President.

The roll was called and the following were recorded present: 157 Present, 22 Absent-excused, 2 Absent. (Record 1, Appendix)

#### LEAVE OF ABSENCE

(President in the Chair)

Delegate Vecchio explained Section 1 of Article IV. There were no amendments offered to Section 1.

Delegate Von Dohlen explained Section 2 of Article IV.

Delegate Hale moved that Article IV be considered section by section as provided in Section 10 of Rule XIV.

The motion prevailed by the following vote: 136 Yeas, 5 Nays, 1 Present-Not Voting, 39 Not Voting. (Record 2, Appendix)

Accordingly, the President laid before the Convention Section 1 of Article IV.

Delegate Ogg offered the following amendment to Article IV:

Amend Article IV, Section 1 by making the following changes:

1) That Article IV, Section 1 read as follows:

Sec. 1. OFFICERS. The governor is the chief executive officer of the state. Officers of the executive department of the executive branch are the governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, comptroller of public accounts, ~~treasurer~~, commissioner of the general land office, secretary of state, and those other officers as provided by law.

2) That Article IV, Section 2(a) read as follows:

Sec. 2. SELECTION AND TERMS OF OFFICERS. (a) At general elections beginning in 1978 qualified voters of the state shall elect the governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, comptroller of public accounts, ~~treasurer~~, the commissioner of the general land office, and those other elected officers provided by law for four-year terms.

3) That a new section be added to read as follows:

Section \_\_\_\_\_. TREASURER. The treasurer shall perform the duties provided by law.

The amendment was read.

(Delegate Calhoun in the Chair)
