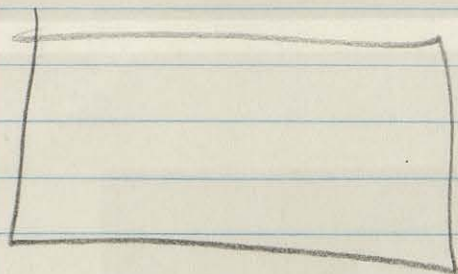

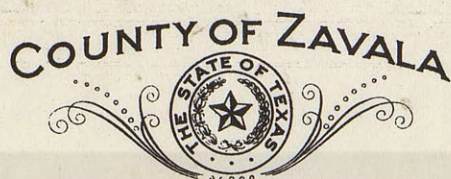

GENERAL RULES:

1. Net proceeds from all events sponsored by outside individuals or organizations cannot be used for betterment of such individuals, but must be spent or given to some worthy community activity approved by the School Board.
2. Requisitionist must collect and remit to Collector of Internal Revenue, full admission tax, make proper report and assume full responsibility for any such taxes.

~~XXX Only food equipment and plates, tables, chairs, etc. XXXX furnished by the school.~~

~~XXX School does not furnish, nor is responsible for, nor own, nor operate, nor maintain, nor repair, nor transport, nor store, nor insure, nor replace, nor dispose of, nor any other equipment, materials, or supplies.~~

5. Three copies of requisition must reach the Business Office five (5) days in advance of event.
6. Requisitionist and his organization, or both will be responsible for the proper use of buildings and equipment and will pay for all damage done, exclusive of ordinary wear and tear. The School will furnish a faculty member for supervision from whom the requisitionist must receive permission for use of any of the facilities of the Lubbock Independent School District not directly agreed to or explained in his original request or in this contract.
7. Fees charged by the Board for expenses of operation will be governed by rules and regulations adopted by the Board and based upon the actual cost of operation.
8. All requests for use of school property will be considered on their merits.
9. The requisitionist, and the organization which he represents, shall, in consideration of the use of school property upon a cost basis, as specified herein, herein and hereby agrees and undertakes to save and hold harmless the school district from any and all claims for damages, personal or otherwise, that may arise out of the use of said building or grounds upon which it is situated, whether by a member of his organization or other person using or enjoying said property, and without regard to whether the damage, personal or otherwise, shall be brought about or caused by the negligent operation of said building by requisitionist.
10. The requisitionist shall be responsible to see that no smoking shall be allowed on the stage or in the auditorium, except in lobbies, of any of the buildings of the Lubbock Independent School District. The requisitionist shall further see that there shall be no drinking of intoxicating beverages in any of the buildings or on any of the properties of the Lubbock Independent School District used by him and/or his organization.

RULES GOVERNING THE USE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY BY OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS AND BY INDIVIDUALS

- I. The rental or free use of buildings and grounds belonging to Lubbock Independent School District, hereinafter termed "Property" shall be governed by the following rules and with the approval of the Board of Trustees. All applications for use of property must be made on regular school requisition form and addressed to the Office of Business Manager. Decision will be made by the Business Office on basis of merit.
- II. Property shall not be rented or used for personal or organization profit, gain or advertisement of any nature.
- III. Auditoriums may be rented to religious organizations on payment of the prescribed fees with the understanding they will not be used for sectarian purposes.
- IV. Property shall not be rented or used for public dances, boxing, wrestling or similar exhibitions.
- V. Property shall not be rented or used for un-American, sacrilegious, and controversial purposes.
- VI. Sunday events inside of buildings will be discouraged as much as possible. Sunday use of playgrounds while not looked upon with favor, will not be policed by the Board. In the event an activity becomes a public nuisance it shall be stopped.
- VII. Property rented or used under these rules will be confined space and fixed equipment, and must be listed in approved requisition.
- VIII. All applications will be considered as an agreement, that responsible parties will accept responsibility for the compliance with rules as herein outlined and also for the proper care and protection of school property, and will see that damage done is paid for.
- IX. Miscellaneous property belonging to the District cannot be loaned or removed from the premises.
- X. Rental fees will be classified as "expense" and are estimated and approved as follows:
 - A. Auditorium—Senior High School—Day or Night (Min.) \$100.00
 - B. Auditorium—Junior High School—Day or Night 50.00
 - C. Auditorium—Rehearsals—Senior High—Day or Night 50.00
 - D. Auditorium—Rehearsals—Junior High School 25.00
 - E. Gymnasiums & Cafeterias—Sr. & Jr. High—Day or Night—Same as for Auditorium in Senior and Junior High.
 - F. Commercial rates for the above facilities shall be as follows:
 1. Senior High School—Day Performance..... \$350.00
 2. Senior High School—Night Performance..... 500.00
 3. Junior High School—Day Performance..... 150.00
 4. Junior High School—Night Performance 250.00
 - G. In addition to the above rates shown in A through F, a charge of \$5.00 per hour will be made after the fourth hour of use. This charge is made to cover the additional expense of keeping school personnel on duty beyond the four hour period.

Other Facilities—Rate to be established by School Business Office.

Athletic events, in addition to expenses shown above, will require users to furnish ticket sellers and handlers, traffic officers, and assume other expense.

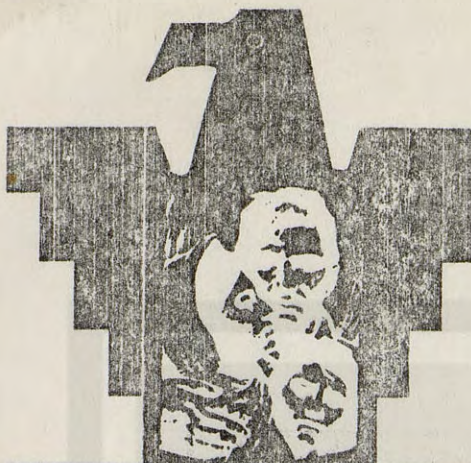
