

Ferguson AKA Three Forks Cemetery

William McCune born Aug 28, 1823 died Sept 9, 1905

A. P. McCune born Jan 7, 1834 died April 25, 1912 **probably woman

James G. Ferguson, for many years a resident of Belton, was born in Arkansas December 18, 1836 and died June 7, 1919 at his home in South Belton on South Pearl street. He fought throughout the Civil War. He was buried in the Three Forks Cemetery southeast of Belton. He was the son of William Ferguson and Nancy Wright Ferguson. His cause of death was paralysis.

R. E. England, farmer, died March 13, 1936***ck*** at the home of Curtis Latham after a short illness. He would have been 90 in November. He lived in Bell County for 40 years. His son Joe England lived in Oklahoma. Miss Lita McDaniel and Mrs. Alice Curry were his granddaughters. He was buried at Ferguson Cemetery. His birth date was 26 November 1846 and his cause of death was influenza and senility.

Joe Furnance born Sept 22, 1833 died Apr 22, 1910 CSA

John F. Ferguson was in Co. C 30th Cav. in the Civil War.
