I was in all the battles in which the above named Brigade took part up to and including the Battle of Mansfield Louisiana on the 8th day of April 1864, at which I was shot through the right thigh - had my right leg broken between the ankle and knee and also had my right hip shot out of place; after which I served as Brigade Clerk from Oct 27th 1864, until the War ended in May 1865.
