Our Command operated altogether on this side of the Mississippi River in the State of Arkansas, Louisiana and Texas, I was Commissary Sergeant of my Company, and participated in a battle at Sirmorse Bayou below Grandmason in which three Infantry Regiments of our Division were engaged viz Roberts, Freights and King, besides Genl Green's Cavalry Division. I was also engaged in the Battle of Jenkins Ferry on the Saline River in Arkansas where our whole Army Corps was engaged, the Union forces were under the Command of Genl Steen in this engagement I was wounded in the left hand and received a furlough to go home after which I was detached on special detail duty as Patternmaker at Naches Foundry 18 miles north of Jefferson Tex and served
