Tweed/Marriage affidavit from Benjamin Foster for Mr. Benjamin Sands and Ms. Margaret Mical/Affidavit of marriage from Joseph H. Price for Mr. Richard Tweed, Jr. and Ms. Margaret M. Sands, 1873-10-01

Know all Men by these Presents, That  
J. William M. Tweed, of the City, County & State of New York

for value received, have sold, and by these presents do grant, assign, and convey  
unto

Mrs Margaret Tweed, wife of Richard Tweed  
of the same place, a portion of my claim against  
the Executors of the Estate of Mrs Richard Tweed  
(lately deceased) to the amount of Five Hundred  
Dollars.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mrs Margaret Tweed  
her executors, administrators and assigns, for ever, to and for the use of  
the said Mrs Margaret Tweed  
hereby constituting and appointing said Mrs Margaret Tweed  
true and lawful attorney irrevocable in my name, place and stead, for the  
purpose aforesaid, to ask, demand, sue for, attach, levy, recover and receive all  
such sum and sums of money as now are, or may hereafter become due, owing  
and payable, for or on account of all or any of the accounts, dues, debts and  
demands above assigned, to the amount of Five hundred Dollars.

giving and granting unto the said attorney full power and authority to do and  
perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary, as fully,  
to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do, if personally present,  
with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming  
all that the said attorney or my substitute shall lawfully do, or cause to be  
done, by virtue hereof.
