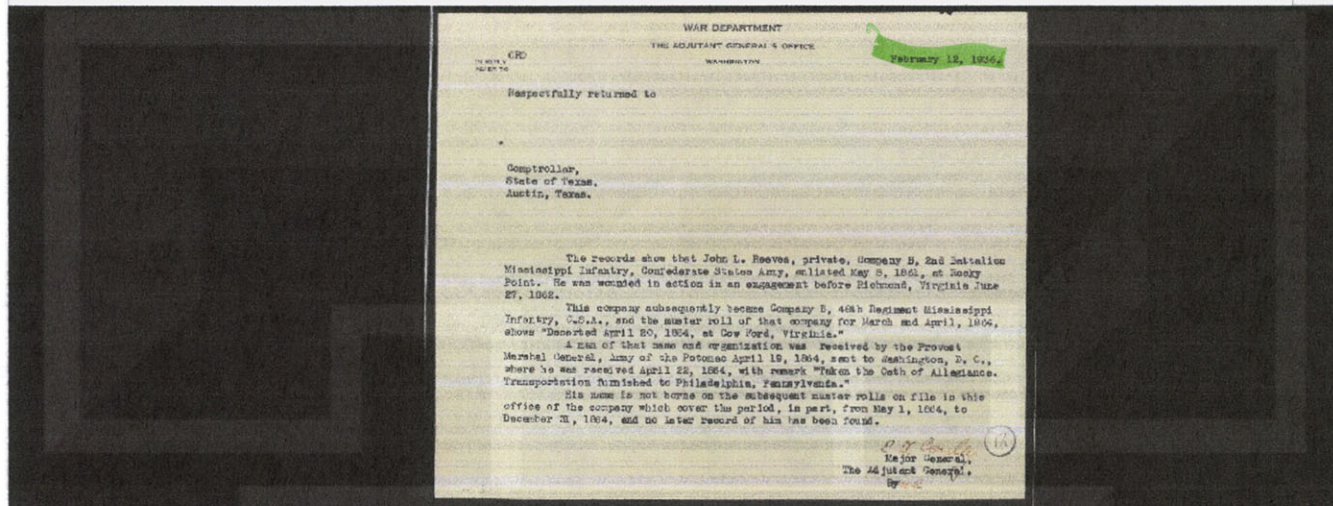

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The records show that John L. Reeves, private, Company B, 2nd Battalion Mississippi Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted May 8, 1861, at Rocky Point. He was wounded in action in an engagement before Richmond, Virginia June 27, 1862.

This company subsequently became Company B, 48th Regiment Mississippi Infantry, C.S.A., and the muster roll of that company for March and April, 1864, shows "Deserted April 20, 1864, at Cow Ford, Virginia."

A man of that name and organization was received by the Provost Marshal General, Army of the Potomac April 19, 1864, sent to Washington, D. C., where he was received April 22, 1864, with remark "Taken the Oath of Allegiance. Transportation furnished to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania."

His name is not borne on the subsequent muster rolls on file in this office of the company which cover the period, in part, from May 1, 1864, to December 31, 1864, and no later record of him has been found.
