Referring to the recent withdrawal of our "Melrose"

contract from the State of Texas, we find it the sense of the majority of the trade that a uniform card selling price should be observed by the Jobbers. Prominent merchants in the State express the opinion that the Trust Law recently enacted was not meant to prohibit contracts of the nature of the "Melrose" contract, but, as its terms expressly forbid "entering into any obligation or agreement by which parties shall bind themselves not to sell any article below a common standard figure", and it is our desire to abide by the letter of the law, we are unwilling to re-establish any actual contract or agreement until the Courts have passed upon the clause in question. It will, however, be injurious to us and to our patrons alike to have the price of "Melrose" indiscriminately cut, and we surely have the right to refuse to sell the "Melrose" to any house that may injure us and injure the trade generally by such action. We feel therefore that the course adopted by us as set forth in the following is clearly within the law. -






